SUMMARY



On August 2, 2015, between the hours of 12:37 pm and 3:44 pm, an African American female Realtor was hosting an open house in the 100 block of O'Neil Circle in the City of Hercules. During that time, the victim received several repeated phone calls and voicemails from a male adult later identified as 51 year old Raymond Anciaux of Hercules. During these phone calls and voicemails, Anciaux called the victim and left several racial and gender slurs and threatened to kill her, stated he did not want her in his neighborhood. Through further investigation the phone number used to place these calls were determined to be from Anciaux's cell phone.

On August 4, 2015, at about 2:42 pm, after being interviewed, Hercules Police Department placed Anciaux under arrest for committing a Hate Crime, Annoying Phone Calls and Repeated Annoying Phone calls. Anciaux was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
