## WATCH COMMANDER'S SHIFT REPORT

**Vandalism:** On January 14, 2016 at 6:40am an officer was dispatched to Willow Food & Liquors for a report of a vandalism. The reporting party said, between 6:35am and 6:40am this morning, an unknown suspect shattered a side window of the business with a brick. No entry was made into the business.

**Identity Theft:** On January 14, 2016 at 9:08am an officer was dispatched to the 1200 block of Canterbury for a report of identity theft. The reporting party said an unknown suspect attempted to open a line of credit using her identifying information.

**Identity Theft:** On January 14, 2016 at 9:37am an officer contacted the reporting party via telephone regarding identity theft. The reporting party said during a check of his credit report he found activity/accounts that he did not authorize.

**Outside Assist/Felony Evading** On January 14<sup>th</sup> 2016 at approximately 9:11PM, HPD units were notified that CCCSO deputies were in pursuit of a silver BMW SUV on WB Hwy 4. As the pursuit neared the city limits a HPD Officer observed the SUV take the Willow Ave exit and turn northbound. CCCSO deputies were held up in traffic and Hercules PD took over the pursuit. The pursuit continued northbound on Willow Ave and reached a top speed of approximately 85MPH. The SUV failed to stop at multiple red lights and stop signs. The SUV stopped at the dead end of California St and 4 suspects fled on foot. A perimeter was established using HPD and CCCSO personnel. A firearm was found near the SUV. No suspects were located. The case is being handled by CCCSO.

**Residential Burglary** On January 14<sup>th</sup> 2016 at approximately 8:21 a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Regatta Point for a residential burglary report. The reporting party said his residence was broken into

sometime within the last week. Entry was made via a garage window. Two laptop computers were taken from an adjacent room. The victim did not notice the missing items or the open window till today.

**Grand Theft** On January 14<sup>th</sup> 2016 at approximately 10:07PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Meadowlark Way for theft of packages. The reporting party said he had multiple packages delivered to his residence, on January 11<sup>th</sup>, but he never received them.

**Possession of a Forged Prescription:** On January 15, 2016 at 4:09pm officers were dispatched to Rite-Aid on a report of an attempt to submit forged prescriptions for controlled drugs. 34 year old Anita Maria Quintana, of Vallejo, was taken into custody and later cited out.

**Outside Assist (Vallejo PD):** On January 15, at approximately 4:30pm, HPD officers were contacted by a 34 year old female, from Vallejo. The female claimed she was being forced into prostitution (all incidents in Vallejo). An outside agency assist case, for human trafficking, was taken. Vallejo PD contacted and advised.

**Outside Assist:** On January 16, 2016, at about 3:01 am, Hercules Officers responded to the 2900 block of Estates, at the request of Pinole PD, to assist with an adult male threatening to kill himself with a handgun. Pinole PD contacted the male and determined that he did not meet the criteria for a mental health evaluation. Pinole PD verified there was no weapons present. Pinole PD took a report. HPD provided cover and perimeter support.

**Petty Theft:** On January 16, 2016 at 3:30pm an officer was dispatched to 200 block of Sparrow for a report of mail theft. The officer contacted the reporting party via telephone. The reporting party said sometime after 2:00pm today an unknown suspect stole items from her mailbox.

**Misdemeanor Warrant (cite Release):** On January 16, 2015 at 11:54 PM an officer stopped a vehicle, on Willow Ave at San Pablo Ave, for a non-working third brake lamp. During the stop the officer learned that 22 year old Release Mclane had a citable Misdemeanor warrant issued on 12/10/2015 for burglary. Mclane was cited and released on scene.

**Petty Theft:** On January 17, 2016 at 9:04 a.m. a supervisor processed an online police report regarding a petty theft from an unlocked vehicle. The reporting party, who live in the 100 block of Schooner Cove, stated an unknown suspect gained entry into his car sometime between 5:00 p.m. on 01/03/16 and 8:00 a.m. on 01/04/16.

**Stolen Vehicle:** On January 17, 2016 at 9:27 a.m. an Officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Beechnut Drive to take a stolen vehicle report. The reporting party said at 9:00 a.m. this morning he noticed his Gray '93 Toyota Camry was missing/stolen from his driveway. The reporting party stated his son last saw the Camry in the driveway last night at approximately 7:00 p.m. or 8:00 p.m.

**Recovered Stolen Vehicle:** During the above investigation the reporting party said there was a White '95 Toyota Camry, which he did not recognize, parked in front of his house in the 200 block of Beechnut. The officer determined the vehicle was reported stolen today to CHP-Oakland. The vehicle was recovered.

**Annoying or Harassing phone calls:** On January 17, 2016 at 9:38 a.m. An Officer was dispatched, to the 1100 block of Regatta Point, to take a report for annoying or harassing phone calls. The reporting party said he received a call this morning, from an unknown female caller, threatening him and his family. The reporting party said he received several similar calls from the same female caller last night as well.

**Possible Pinole P.D. Theft Suspect:** On January 17, 2016 at 2:14 p.m. a Parking Enforcement Volunteer observed an occupied vehicle, parked at the Creekside Center, near Taco Bell. The vehicle, a Black '04 Hyundai Sonata, with No Plates, was occupied by an adult male. The Parking Volunteer observed the Sonata had chipped paint on the hood as well as duct tape holding the hood closed. The vehicle's occupant, and the vehicle, matched the suspect & suspect vehicle description from a recent theft in Pinole. A HPD Officer contacted the occupant of the vehicle and sent the information to Pinole PD for follow-up.

**Possible Endangerment:** On January 17, 2015 at 6:00pm a mother reported her son 7 year old son told her his father put him in the trunk of the car and took him for a ride. The incident reportedly occurred on Friday January 15, 2016. The child stated he was in the trunk for 3-10 minutes. He said his daddy said he might have to fight someone, and did not want the child to see. The father denied the incident. The child showed no sign of injury or trauma. The case has been referred to investigations for follow-up

**Warrant Arrest:** On January 17, 2016 at 9:30 PM Hercules Officer's served an arrest warrant at a residence in the 100 block of Wadi Run. 18 year old Jose Fernandez for his outstanding Welfare and Institution Code warrant issued on January 13, 2016. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
