**Found Property:** On January 18, 2016 at 10:56 a.m. an Officer contacted two adult male pedestrians, walking W/B in the 1500 Block of Sycamore Ave. They were pushing a Home Depot shopping cart loaded with recyclables. Both males stated they were transients. One of the males was in possession of a Debit card which was issued to another person. The debit card owner was contacted and stated he lost the card and had closed the account. He did not indicate he wanted the property back. The Debit card was later entered into Evidence as Safekeeping. Both males were released.

**Misdemeanor Warrant arrest (Cite Release):** On January 18, 2016 at 7:24 PM an officer arrested 34 year old Eshane Buie, at her residence, in the 100 block of Glenwood. Buie had an outstanding Misdemeanor Warrant, issued January 6, 2016. The officer issued Buie a citation, with a court date, and released her at the scene.

**Auto Burglary PC 459:** On January 18, 2016 at 8:03 PM a resident from the 100 block of Larkspur Ct reported his 2003 Chevrolet Tahoe had been burglarized. The reporting party said he parked and locked his vehicle, in his driveway, on December 26, 2015 and left the on vacation. He returned today and noticed the sunroof was missing from his Tahoe.. Also missing from the vehicle were the radio and instrument cluster.

**Criminal Treats:** On January 17, 2016 at 9:17 PM a resident from the 500 block of Mahogany reported an unknown male knocked on her front door. When she looked out the window the unknown male made verbal threats, stating she had property which was not hers. The male is described as an African American male; 35 years old; 5-11; and 150lbs.
