**Lost Property:** On January 19, 2016 at 2:40 p.m. an Officer was dispatched to a lobby detail to take a lost property report. The reporting party said he couldn't find his Indian Passport when he went to look for it today. The passport was saw his within the past week and a half.

**Driving Under the Influence of Drugs and Probation Violation:** On January 20, 2015 at 12:56 AM Hercules Officers were dispatched to an accident at McDonalds, at 1579 Sycamore Ave. Officers contacted the drivers of the two vehicles at the front of the drive thru line. The investigation indicated the driver of the second vehicle, 29 year old Lejuan Thomas of Hercules, ran his vehicle into the rear of the first car in front of him twice. Thomas was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test and it was determined he was under the influence of a DRUG. Thomas was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Drugs. Thomas is on Felony Probation and was also charged with Violation of Probation. He transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Auto Burglary:** On January 20, 2016 at 3:20 AM an officer was dispatched to Lucky's for an Auto Burglary. The reporting party, a Lucky Employee, said sometime between 9:00 PM and the time of call an unknown subject shattered her right front window and took her black purse.

**Felony & Misdemeanor Warrant Arrest:** On January 20, 2016 at 3:40 AM Hercules Officers were dispatched to Jack in the Box at 3800 San Pablo Ave. for a subject banging on the windows. The suspect was described as having a black jacket, and was gone when officers arrived. Officers conducted an area check and located a subject, wearing a black jacket, at the Shell station (which is located in front of the Jack in the Box). With the use of the mobile ID system the subject was identified as 25 year old Aaron Custard, of Rodeo. Custard was found to have a Misdemeanor Warrant
