Towed Vehicle – Vehicle Blocking: On January 27, 2016, at about 7:35 am, an Officer was flagged down regarding a vehicle collision on Turquoise Dr. Officers located a Silver 2011 Toyota Corolla that had collided into a parked vehicle in the 400 block of Turquoise Dr. The driver had already exchanged information with the owner of the parked vehicle and had contacted AAA for a tow. However, AAA had not yet arrived for a tow. Dispatch contacted AAA to get an ETA and they advised they would be extended. A rotation tow was then requested due to the Corolla blocking the roadway.

Extra Patrol: On January 27, 2016, at about 9:13 am, Officers were dispatched to an alarm activation in the 1500 block of Partridge Drive. The residence was found to be secure and the homeowner responded and arrived while Officers were still on scene. The residents have already been the recent victim of a residential burglary. The homeowner said she saw a suspicious unfamiliar BMJ subject standing in front of her house this morning at approximately 7:45 am. She said the BMJ was approximately 16-17 years old, wearing a dark colored hoodie, with no backpack. She said he stood outside watching her and the house as she was leaving with her kids. The homeowner requested extra patrol of the area.

Driving on a Suspended Driver's License: On January 27, 2016, at about 11:08 am, an Officer initiated a traffic enforcement stop on a Silver 2013 Nissan Altima for not displaying any license plates in the 4000 block of San Pablo Ave. The driver was identified as 45 year old Siobhan Williams of Rodeo. Williams was found to be driving on a suspended or revoked driver's license and was cited and released.

Unlicensed Driver: On January 28, 2016, at about 1:29 am, an Officer initiated a traffic enforcement stop on a 2003 Nissan Murano at San Pablo

Ave and Sycamore Ave for not displaying any license plates. The driver, 35 year old Kimberlee Dishmon of Rodeo was determined to be driving without a valid driver's license and was cited and released.

Recovered carjacked vehicle: On January 28, 2016 at about 8:34 am, an Officer responded to a tow yard in Vallejo to process the recovered Ford van that was located unoccupied in Vallejo after a citizen called VPD and HPD yesterday to report finding the vehicle parked IFO their home.

Warrant Arrest: On January 28, 2016, at about 10:34 am, a resident in the 100 block of Beryl Ct reported two suspicious BMA's carrying backpacks ringing doorbells in the area. They were located on foot at Turquoise and Lapis and one of the subjects was identified as 39 year old 48 year old Timothy Jasper of Sacramento. Jasper was found to be on probation out of Sacramento County for burglary and had an outstanding felony burglary probation violation warrant for his arrest. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility for the warrant.

Battery on School Grounds: On January 28, 2016, at about 10:34 am, an Officer took a report for a physical altercation between two male students at the Hercules Middle High School campus.

Expired Driver's License Violation: On January 28, 2016, at about 10:17 pm, an Officer initiated a traffic enforcement stop on a 2006 Dodge Caravan at John Muir Pkwy and the I-80 westbound onramp for an expired registration violation. The driver, 52 year old Jian Zheng Fang of Hercules was determined to be driving while his driver's license was expired. Fang was also determined to be on active probation out of San Francisco County for possession of a controlled substance. The registration on the van was expired in 2014 and the van was subsequently towed.

Illegal Transportation of Marijuana and Probation Violation: During the inventory of the van noted in the above incident, a large garbage bag containing about four pounds of Marijuana and a brown paper bag containing about three pounds of Marijuana were located in the rear passenger compartment. Fang was placed under arrest for Illegal transportation of Marijuana and transported to the Hercules Police Department for further investigation. Fang was later transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Auto Burglary: On January 29, 2016, at about 3:50 am, an Officer took a report for an Auto Burglary that was reported on-line that possibly occurred in the 1300 block of Willow Ave sometime between 9:00 am and 8:30 pm

on January 28, 2016. A car stereo, USB flash drive, garage door opener and books were taken.

Warrant Arrest: On January 29, 2016, at about 10:28 am, an Officer initiated a traffic enforcement stop on a 2002 Honda Accord in the Park Lake Plaza shopping center for a handicap parking violation. A passenger, 56 year old Dinah Washington of Rodeo was determined to have an outstanding \$5,000 no-cite warrant for Possession of Stolen Property and Theft held by Pinole PD. Washington was placed under arrest and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Court Order & Multiple Probation Violations: On January 29, 2016, at about 8:36 pm, Officers responded to a residence in the 1200 block of Canterbury for a reported unwanted subject identified as 47 year old William Brossard of Hercules. Brossard was determined to be on three separate probations out of Contra Costa County and a restrained party in a court order. The reporting party is the protected party and she signed a Complainant's Arrest form and Brossard was placed under arrest and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Fighting in a building: On January 30, 2016, at about 8:40 pm, an Officer responded to a residence in the 2000 block of De Anza Ln for a report of a disturbance between landlord and tenant. Upon arrival it was determined that both parties engaged in a mutual altercation however neither party suffered any significant injuries and both declined prosecution. A civil standby was conducted while the tenant removed her property and returned the house key. A case was taken for documentation purposes only.

Vandalism and Public Intoxication: On January 30, 2016, at about 1:06 am, Officers responded to a residence in the 200 block of Scupper Ct for a vandalism and intoxicated unwanted subject. The victim, reported that his girlfriend, 25 year old Sakora Vernaell of Richmond punched and shattered a window near the entry way to his home after he refused her entry into the home. Vernaell was located in the parking near the residence and was bleeding from her right hand and had a small laceration on her foot from the shattered window. Upon being contacted Vernaell exhibited obvious signs of being heavily intoxicated. The victim said he wanted prosecution against Vernaell and signed a Complainant's Arrest form. Due to Vernaell's injuries, she was transported by AMR to Kaiser in Richmond and was cited and released for vandalism and public Intoxication.

Unlicensed Driver: On January 30, 2016, at about 1:50 am, an Officer initiated a traffic enforcement stop on a 2014 Dodge Dart in the 700 block

of Willow Ave for an inoperable headlight. The driver, 20 year old Wyman Boyd Jr of Union City was determined to be driving without a valid driver's license and on parole for PC 459. A parole search was conducted and no contraband was located. Boyd was cited for being an unlicensed driver.
