Identity Theft: On February 16, 2016 at 9:49 a.m. an Officer was dispatched to a lobby detail to take an identity theft report. The reporting party said she received notices, in the mail, from Nordstrom's and Victoria Secret stating she had opened credit accounts (in store) at the San Francisco locations. The reporting party did not personally open those two credit accounts, nor authorize anyone to do so.

Found Property: On February 16, 2016 at 1:36 p.m. an officer handled a lobby detail regarding found property. A citizen turned in a Wells Fargo Debit Card found lying on the ground on Hercules Ave. near Skelly Way. No local contacts or information was found for the owner. The debit card was entered into Evidence for Safekeeping.

Vandalism/Theft: On February 16, 2016, at approximately 2:44 pm an officer was dispatched to the Swim Center for the report of a vandalized vending machine. Sometime between Friday, February 12, 2016 at 7:00 pm and February 16, 2016 at 2:30 pm someone jumped over the fence into the swimming pool area. They broke open a vending machine and badly damaged it. The cash box was removed and the money was taken.

Misdemeanor warrant arrest: February 16, 2016 6:55 PM an officer was dispatched to Rite Aid for a suspicious subject. The officer contacted 30 year old Brandon Smith, of Hercules. Smith was found to have an outstanding citable misdemeanor warrant. Smith was given a new court date and cited out on scene.

Residential Burglary: February 16, 2016 6:52 PM an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Lotus Court for residential burglary. The reporting party stated he and his wife left the residence at 5:45 AM and returned at 6:50 PM. They entered the residence through the front door and noticed one of their cats was not inside the house. They checked the house

and found the rear sliding glass door unlocked. The reporting party was sure the door he locked the door when he left. The exterior patio room door screen was cut allowing a suspect to reach inside and unlock the door. No items appeared to be missing from the residence.

Vandalism to vehicle: On February 16, 2016 at 7:47 PM an officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Lavender Pl. for vandalism to vehicle. The reporting party said he parked, and locked, his vehicle on Saturday, February 13 at 11:30 PM. He discovered his vehicle window broken today at 7:47 PM. The rear window of his 99 Honda Accord was broken by a long piece of wood which was found lying on the trunk of the vehicle

Identity theft: on February 16, 2016 at 8:11 PM an officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Pepperwood for an identity theft report. The reporting party stated an unknown subject used his Discover card to purchase airline tickets. The total cost was over \$3,000. The first two flights were booked on February 11, and included a Los Angeles to Atlanta flight; and Atlanta to Jacksonville. The return flights are booked for February 18. The purchases were made through Triple A on February 10, 2016.
