Auto Burglary: On February 25, 2016 at 7:09am an officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of White Birch Cove for a report of an auto burglary. The reporting party parked her locked vehicle, in the driveway, last night at about 6:00pm. This morning, she saw that the trunk and driver door of her vehicle were ajar. The vehicle had been ransacked. Miscellaneous items were stolen.

Battery: On February 25, 2016 a Hercules School Resource Officer responded to the 100 block of Driftwood Cove to interview a victim of an assault. The 14 year old Hercules Middle High School student reported being assaulted, on campus, yesterday by another 14 year student.

Identity Theft: On February 25, 2016 at 2:03pm an officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Ben Lomond for a report of identity theft.

Mental Health Evaluation: On February 25, 2016 at 3:50pm officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Crepe Myrtle regarding a 32 year old male having a psychotic episode. The male was contacted in front of his home and determined to meet the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. He was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

Stolen Vehicle: On February 26, 2016, at about 6:21 am, an Officer responded to a residence in the 100 block of Paradise Dr for a reported stolen black 4DR 1990 Honda Civic. The vehicle was taken between midnight and the time of call.

Found Property: On February 26, 2016, at about 6:21 am, an Officer was investigating the above incident. The officer found a gray Murray's men's bicycle, and a pair of red bolt cutters in the area where the vehicle was stolen. It is unknown if these items were associated with the vehicle theft. Both items were taken and entered into safekeeping.

Theft: On February 26, 2016 at 2:14pm an officer was dispatched to Valley Bible Church for a report of a theft. The reporting party said, sometime between 8:00am yesterday and 12:00pm today, an unknown suspect stole the church's portable hot dog cart.

Traffic Collision: On February 27, 2016, at about 3:27 am, an Officer responded to the area of Hercules Ave and Titan for a reported collision between a 2008 GMC and a parked vehicle. An exchange of information was completed.

Auto Burglary: On February 27, 2016 at 3:07pm an officer was dispatched to 3500 Franklin Canyon Road regarding an auto burglary. The report was second hand information from an employee. The officer located a Toyota Highlander with the rear passenger side window shattered. Attempts were made to contact the owner, or driver, with negative results. A note was left, on the vehicle, to contact HPD. As of 7:00pm the owner/driver of the Highlander had not made contact.

Mental Health Evaluation: On February 27, 2016 at 6:22pm officers were dispatched to 2100 block of Forest Run for a welfare check on a 27 year old female and her young son. The female had been at the offices of Social Service and told the Social Worker she needed assistance. The female and child left before assistance was provide. Officers contacted the female at her home. Officers determined the female met the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. Her son was left in the custody of his grandmother.

Drunk in Public: On February 27, 2016, at 8:30pm hours, Officers were dispatched, to the area Shell, for a report of a vehicle speeding and hitting a curb. Officers located the vehicle parked in the #2 lane of Sycamore Ave, just east of Willow Ave. Three adult male subjects were standing on the sidewalk next to the vehicle. Officers could not determine who driving at the time of the incident. Two of the males displayed obvious signs of intoxication. 44 year old Johnny Smith, of Albany; and 28 year old William Carter, of Vallejo, were arrested for being drunk in public. Both males were transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The third subject was released at the scene.

Driving under the influence of alcohol/ under 21: On February 27, 2016, at 11:39pm hours, an Officer made a traffic stop on vehicle for running a red light. The 17 year old male driver, of Richmond, displayed signs of intoxication. He was arrested for a Minor Driving under the Influence of Alcohol. He was cited, and released to a responsible adult.

Driving Under the Influence: On February 28, 2016 at 1:06pm, an officer conducted a traffic stop in the 2000 block of Refugio Valley Road. The driver, 68 year old Jacqueline Ann Cook of Albany, was determined to be driving a suspended license. During the contact, the officer suspected Cook was intoxicated. Limited Standard Field Sobriety Tests were administered due to Cook's complaints of physical pain. Cook was arrested for Driving under the Influence of Alcohol. She was cited and released to a responsible party.

Auto Burglary: On February 28, 2016 at 8:06 PM a resident from the 100 block of Hawk Ct. reported an unknown person shattered one of his van's windows. The incident occurred between 7:00 PM and the time of call. The suspect stole a backpack containing electronic items.

Auto Burglary: On February 28, 2016 at 8:57 PM an officer was dispatched to the corner of Bobolink and Hawk Ct. for a report of two suitcases on the curb. The officer located a Nissan, in the 200 block of Bobolink, with a rear window shattered. The suspect removed the two empty suitcases and left them on the curb. The vehicle owner said she parked, and locked, her Nissan in front of her residence at 6:00 PM.

Suspended Driver/Providing False Name to Peace Officer: On February 29, 2016, at approximately 10:29 am, an officer stopped a yellow GMC box truck, on O'Neil Circle, for expired registration. The driver gave a name which could not be verified. He was identified, by the use of a finger print scanner, as 49 year old-Eleuterio DelacruzGarcia of Oakland. He had a suspended driver's license. DelacruzGarcia initially gave the false name because his driver's license was suspended and he did not want to get in trouble. DelacruzGarcia was issued a citation for driving with a suspended driver's license, and giving a false name.

Mail Theft: On February 29, 2016, at approximately 10:57am an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of South Shelter for a report of mail theft. The victim showed the officer a surveillance video. The video showed, at approximately 9:01 am, a newer model possibly 2015, charcoal gray four door with a hatch back drove by the front of the residence. The vehicle looked like possibly a Honda Fit or Toyota Prius. The vehicle drove out of view, and subsequently came back into view driving the opposite direction. The driver, who appeared to be an unknown race male wearing a dark colored hooded sweat shirt, drove directly next to the victim's mailbox, opened it, and took a letter from the mailbox. The vehicle then drove away. The driver never got out of the vehicle. The video did not show the license

plate of the vehicle or a better description of the suspect. Attached is the

The victim said he put a letter in his mail box at approximately 8:00 am, and he put the red flag up on the mailbox to let the postal employee know there was mail to go out inside the mail box.

CRIME PREVENTION TIP: Do not leave letters, to be mailed, in your mail box. The red flag not only alerts the mail man, of the mail, it also alerts crooks. Mail all your letters at the post office, or a regulation mail box. It is also suggested residents have locking mail boxes.

Disturbing the Peace on School Grounds: HPD officers were dispatched to Ohlone Elementary School for a disturbance between a teacher and a parent. The parent reportedly used some offensive language, towards the teacher, while the children were present. The teacher wanted to press charges and signed a Complainant's Arrest Form for Disturbing the Peace on school grounds.

Misdemeanor warrant arrest X 2: On February 29, 2016 at 7:33 PM Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Maritime Terrace for a civil standby. Officers determined, one of the parties, 24 year old Yahuaca, Xochici had two out of County misdemeanor warrants. One held by Madera County and the other by Tulare County. Yahuaca was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Vandalism: On February 29, 2016 at 9:15 PM a resident from the 300 block of Sorrento Ct. reported her vehicle was vandalized. The officer located the gray TOYOTA SOLARA LP, with two broken driver side windows, on Miramar near Palermo Ct. Nothing appeared to be disturbed inside the vehicle. The vandalism occurred sometime between 6:30 AM and 5:00PM.

Misdemeanor warrant arrest: On February 29, 2016 at 10:42 PM an officer made a traffic stop in the 700 block of Willow Ave. The driver, 47 year old Mirenda Mlliams of Vallejo, had and outstanding Misdemeanor no bail warrant. Williams was arrested and transported to The Martinez Detention Facility.
