Missing Person (Silver Alert) Located: On March 21, 2016 at 2:44 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to 100 Civic Drive for an outside assist. Alameda County Sheriff's Office asked us to attempt to locate 83 year old female missing person. . She was last seen walking away from her family's home in San Lorenzo. The family thought she was possibly be in-route to Hercules, where she used to live, via public transportation. The woman's family reported her as an at-risk (Dementia) missing person today at 10:00 a.m. Officers went to the woman's former apartment and located her there. She appeared to be in good health. The woman's Son responded to care for her and she was removed from the Missing and Unidentified Persons System.

Grand Theft: On March 21, 2016 at 6:37 PM a resident from the 100 block of Finch reported he ordered several items from a vendor. The reporting party verified the items were delivered, by UPS to his front porch, on March 5, 2016. An unknown subject stole the items, from the porch, before he could collect them. The reporting party contacted the vendor and received replacements for the items. The vendor needed a police report for a record of the loss.
