Suspicious Circumstance: On March 31, 2016 at 9:32am, officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Trellis Bay for a report of a possible abandon grow house. The property owner has been unable to contact the current tenants to schedule a routine inspection. Today he had to have a locksmith come in to gain entry. The house was empty and it was apparent the tenants had moved. The owner observed a couple of floorboard had been cut out. He further observed, what he thought was dried marijuana leaves near the cut outs. The owner believed the house was used to grow or hide large amounts of marijuana. The officer did not locate any other evidence that the home was used for illegal purposes.

Found Property: On March 31, 2016 at 12:23pm an officer was dispatched to the area of Canterbury at Coventry for a report of a found bicycle. The bike was recovered and entered into found property at HPD.

Domestic Battery: On March 31, 2016 at 12:35pm, officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Forest Run regarding a domestic battery. The reporting party said her daughter's father assaulted her. Both parties had minor injuries. Neither party wanted prosecution. At the conclusion of the investigation, it was determined that the incident was mutual combat. Officers were unable to determine who was the dominate aggressor. The case will be forwarded to the District Attorney's Office for review.

Domestic Battery: On March 31, 2016 at 2:35pm officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Willow for a report of a battery. Officers contacted the adult female victim. She stated her and now ex-boyfriend tried to punch her in the face, but missed. The suspect did punch her in the leg. West complained of pain but declined medical attention. The suspect was not at the scene.

Mental Health Evaluation: On March 31, 2016 at 3:05pm officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Starling for a report of an out of control adult male. The reporting party said her son was smashing furniture inside the house. The male met the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation and transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol: On April 1, 2016, at about 1:01 am, an Officer made a traffic stop, in the 1500 block of Sycamore Ave, for speed violations. The driver, 41 year old Jesus Mejia of Hercules, exhibited signs of being under the influence of alcohol, Mejia was administer the Standard Field Sobriety Test, but refused to use the Preliminary Alcohol System. He was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Residential Burglary: On April 1, 2016 at 9:26am officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Violet for a report of an alarm heard sounding for the past 10 minutes. Officers discovered the front door had been forced opened. The house was checked and no one was located inside. The inside of the residence appeared undisturbed. A neighbor told officers he first heard the alarm sounding at about 8:45am but did not call the police. The homeowners could not be reached.

Auto Burglary: On April 1, 2016 at 3:33pm officers were initially dispatched to Rite Aid for a report of a theft from a vehicle. It was determined the theft actually occurred in the 800 block of Willow, near the convenience store next to the 76 station The reporting party is a delivery driver and said he arrived, at approximately 3:00pm, to deliver items to the convenience store. After each trip, he would close the trailer door but not lock it. When he finished his delivery, he checked his inventory. He noticed 2 boxes, containing cartons of cigarettes, were missing.

Court order/ probation violation & possession of a controlled substance: On April 1, 2016, at about 7:20 pm, Officers responded to a residence in the 1200 block of Willow Ave for a report of an unwanted subject identified as 29 year old Shane Jackson. The reporting party has a served temporary restraining order against Jackson. He is also on misdemeanor probation in Contra Costa. Jackson was located in front of the apartment complex. He was in possession of a small baggie containing a substance, believed to be a narcotic; and a vial containing pills, which were believed to be a narcotic. Jackson was placed under arrest for being Violation of a Restraining Order; Possession of a Controlled Substance; and Violation of Probation. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Located Missing Juvenile: On April 1, 2016, at about 9:00 pm, Officers responded to a residence in the 2100 block of Redwood Rd for a report of a 12 year old male subject who ran away from home in Richmond, and went to this address. This is at least the third time that Officers have located the juvenile at this address. The child's mother was contacted and refused to respond to pick up the juvenile. CPS was contacted and took custody of the juvenile.

Found Property: On April 2, 2016 at 11:06am an officer was dispatched to Bank of America regarding a found purse. The officer was unable to contact the owner. The purse was logged into found property at HPD.

Petty Theft: On April 2, 2016 at 12:57pm officers were dispatched to 1560 Sycamore (Rite Aid) for a report of a theft that just occurred. The reporting party said someone stole merchandise from the store and fled westbound on Sycamore Ave in a red Acura Legend 3.0 with front left fender damage. The suspects were described a male, and female, African American Adults. They were net located

Found property: On April 2, 2016 at 12:41pm an officer was dispatched to the 2100 block of Redwood regarding a found backpack. The backpack was booked into evidence for safekeeping.

Battery: On April 2, 2016 at 5:57pm officers were dispatched to the 1500 block of Chelsea for a report an assault. The reporting party said her boyfriend shoved her, during an argument, causing injuries. 64 year old Michael Harp was arrested for battery. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Hit and Run On April 2nd 2016 at approximately 6:43PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Salt Spray Terrace for a hit and run collision. The reporting party stated she was driving her 1998 Infiniti QX4 on Salt Spray Terrace. A silver Honda, driven by a an African American male, struck the left front bumper of her vehicle and fled the scene. The reporting party was not injured and her vehicle sustained very minor damage to the front bumper. An area check was conducted but the suspect and the vehicle were not located.

Mental Health Evaluation On April 2nd 2016 at approximately 8:07PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Violet Rd for a welfare check on a 70 year old female. Family and friends stated they had not heard from her in 5 days and she was not responding to their calls or text messages. Officers were able to make entry via an unlocked side garage door. The female was located in an upstairs bedroom. The female was determined to meet the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. She was

transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center. The female's daughter was notified of her mother's condition.

Outside Assist On April 2nd 2016 at approximately 10:34PM the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Department requested HPD to respond to the area of Allview Way and Appian Way to assist in locating a subject wanted for Auto Theft; Evading Arrest; and Resisting Arrest..

Outside Assist – Attempted Carjacking: On April 3, 2016 at 8:12 a.m. officers were completing a traffic stop, on Willow Ave. at Sycamore Ave, and were flagged down two adult males. The males stated they had been victims of an attempted carjacking. It was initially thought the incident occurred in Hercules. It was later learned the crime occurred in the County's jurisdiction. The Contra Costa County Sheriff's Department was notified and took over the investigation.

Security Check of Hercules Point (City Property): On April 3, 2016 at 11:37 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to a citizen's report regarding homeless people camping on Northern portion of the Point. Officers did a security check on foot and contacted two males fishing. Officers also contacted a 64 year old female, transient. She was sleeping inside a tent near the grove of trees on the Southwest portion of the Point. The female has been warned about trespassing in the past. She was advised she would be cited if contacted again.

Auto Burglary: On April 3, 2016 at 5:57 p.m. an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Carson St. to take a vandalism report. The reporting party said an unknown suspect shattered the right front passenger window of his Gray '15 Honda Accord, sometime between 5:30 p.m. and the time of call. The unknown suspect reached inside the Accord and stole two pair of expensive prescription eyeglasses.

Runaway Juvenile: On April 3, 2016 at 6:23 p.m. an officer was dispatched to the 2100 block of Lupine Rd. to take a runaway juvenile report. The reporting party said his 17 year old daughter left home, this past Friday night at 7:30 p.m. on a date and has not returned home. She took a bag with extra clothes with her. The juvenile had contact with her Father on Friday night and texted her Father Saturday night. The juvenile was entered into the Missing and Unidentified Persons System.

Petty Theft PC 488: On April 3, 2016 at 8:22 PM a Hercules resident reported the 2017 registration tab was stolen from her 2004 Mercedes C240. The theft occurred at an unknown location between March 1 and April 2, 2016.

Felony Warrant Arrest: On April 3, 2016 at 9:55 PM Hercules Officers contacted 31 year old Juan Murillo, at his residence in the 100 block of Brighton Street, and arrested him on his outstanding felony warrant. Murillo was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
