Vandalism: On March 30, 2016 at 6:47am an officer was dispatched to Village Parkway for a report of an auto burglary. The reporting party said, sometime between 6:30pm yesterday and 6:00am today, an unidentified suspect shattered the rear window of his vehicle. There was no evidence that entry was made into the vehicle.

Auto Burglary: On March 30, 2016 at 10:33am an officer responded to Village Parkway for a report of an auto burglary. The reporting party said, sometime between 8:10am yesterday and time of call today, an unknown suspect shattered the rear window of his Ford Explorer and stole \$500 worth of his property.

Warrant Arrest: On March 30, 2016 at 10:42am, officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Thistle Ct for a report of an unwanted subject. The reporting party said an unknown subject was in her backyard. Officers contacted the caller's boyfriend in front of the residence. The caller recanted her story about not knowing the identity of the subject in her yard. 25 year old Brandon Jackson, of Oakland, had a no cite misdemeanor warrant, held by this agency. He was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol: On March 30, 2016 at 4:12pm officers were dispatched to John Muir Parkway, at Alfred Nobel, for a report of an unoccupied green Ford Explorer, with a flat tire, blocking the right lane of westbound John Muir. While the officer was towing the Ford, for blocking the roadway, he was advised the female driver was about a block away and her appearance was disheveled. The female was located at the corner of John Muir and San Pablo Ave. The female displayed objective symptoms of alcohol intoxication. She was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test.
