**Outside Assist – Property Damage Only Vehicle Collision:** On April 6, 2016 at 9:56 a.m. Hercules Officers responded to an outside assist, for Pinole PD, for a vehicle collision on San Pablo Ave. at 5<sup>th</sup> St. in Pinole. A Gray '14 Honda Accord, and a Blue '07 Toyota RAV 4, were the involved vehicles. The driver of the Accord requested an ambulance due to chest pain, and was transported to the hospital prior to the officers' arrival. Both vehicles were blocking the roadway and were moved out of the way.

**Theft by False Pretense:** On April 6, 2016, at approximately 1320 hours, an HPD Officer was dispatched to HPD lobby for a fraud report. An 83 year old male Hercules resident said he has been dating a person (who said they were a female), via the internet for the last four months. The male has sent the "girlfriend", via wire transfers, several thousand dollars over the last three months. The suspect convinced the victim to send her \$30,000.00 because she had received a family inheritance in gold, and she needed the money for the storage and transfer fees. The victim transferred the money from his bank account to a bank account in New Jersey, where the suspect supposedly lives. The bank alerted the victim this transaction may be fraudulent. The bank was able to stop transfer of most of the funds. Further follow up investigation is being done.

**Hit & Run:** On April 6, 2016, at about 8:09 pm, a citizen reported a hit and run just occurred while they were shopping at Home Depot. An unknown vehicle collided into front of their 2015 Kia Sorrento that was parked in a stall in front of the store.
