Traffic Collision/Exchange of Info Only: On April 15, 2016 4:10pm an officer responded to 1570 Sycamore regarding a two car traffic collision. There was minor damage to both vehicle and no complaints of pain. The officer assisted the involved parties in exchanging information.

Traffic Collision: On April 15, 2016 at 6:23pm officers were dispatched to San Pablo Ave at Sycamore for a report of a traffic collision involving a passenger vehicle and a WestCat bus. There were no reports of injuries and the damage to both vehicles was minor. A WestCat supervisor responded to the scene.

Traffic Collision: On April 15, 2016, at about 7:35 pm, Officers responded to the Big Lots parking lot located in the 1500 block of Sycamore Ave for a reported traffic collision between a 2008 Chevy Tahoe and a 2012 Honda. A property damage only exchange of information was facilitated between both parties.

Felony Evading/ Driving under the influence: On April 16, 2016, at about at about 1:35 am, an Officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop on a 2003 Chevy Impala, in the 800 block of Willow Ave, for speed violations. The Impala failed to yield and accelerated to speeds of about 100 mph while failing to stop at several traffic signals. A pursuit was initiated and the Impala continued northbound on Willow Ave towards Parker Ave. The driver finally yielded at the corner of Parker Ave. The driver, and lone occupant, was identified as 32 year old Ronnie Jamal Hill Jr of Fairfield/ Merced. Hill exhibited signs of being under the influence of an alcoholic beverage and was also determined to be driving while his driver's license was expired. Hill was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility for felony evading, driving under the Influence and driving while his driver's license was expired.

Identity Theft: On April 16, 2016 at 9:39am, an officer was dispatched to 2000 Clark St regarding identity theft. The reporting party said someone wrote fraudulent checks using her identifying information. The checks were counterfeited to resemble BofA checks.

Outside Assist: On April 16, 2016, at about 11:54pm, Officers responded to the 1500 block of Partridge Drive to assist CCC Sheriff's investigators with contacting a witness who also had a no bail probation violation warrant in held by Vacaville PD. Hercules Officers assisted with a perimeter and entry into the residence. The witness was located inside the residence and taken into custody by CCCSO. No further assistance was required

Lost Property (BobCop): On April 17, 2016 at 11:10 a.m. a supervisor handled an online lost property report. The Antioch resident stated she lost her thin Black Wallet containing "all her stuff" in the parking lot of the Hercules Public Library on 04/14/16 at 2:30 p.m.

Hit and Run Vehicle Collision (BobCop): On April 17, 2016 at 11:27 a.m. a supervisor handled an online hit and run vehicle collision (No Suspect info) report. The reporting party stated he came outside to his parked vehicle this morning (in the 2000 block of Drake Lane) at 10:35 a.m. and saw fresh damage to the left rear bumper. The reporting party stated he noticed a white colored paint transfer was left on his vehicle's rear bumper as a result of the vehicle collision. He also said there was debris left from the suspect vehicle. He last saw his 325XI undamaged at 3:00 a.m. last night, 04/16/16.

Battery: On April 17, 2016 R 5:58 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Partridge Dr. for a report of a fight between two females. The reporting party stated a female was beating up her Mom. The suspect was described as a Caucasian female adult with, blonde hair, driving a Gray vehicle. Officers arrived and saw the described suspect fighting the Hispanic female adult victim. Officers separated the two female. The victim told Officers the suspect drove into her driveway, got out of the vehicle, and attacked her. The victim stated the suspect punched and kicked her multiple times. Both women had cuts and scratches to their upper body. Neither wanted to press charges against the other.

Vandalism: On April 17, 2016 7:58 PM a victim reported an unknown subject(s) broke the rear kitchen window but it did not shatter. The subjects also damaged the fence in the side yard. The unknown individuals broke out several fence boards to gain access to the rear yard. The last time her the residence was seem intact was on March 20, 2016.

Natural Death: On April 18, 2016 at 12:11 AM a resident. from the 400 block of Violet Rd, heard her husband fall. She found him on the floor unable to get up so she called 911. When fire, and the ambulance, arrived the male went into cardiac arrest. RHFD started CPR The male was pronounced deceased at 12:15 AM. The male had prior medical issues and his body was released to the family by the Coroner

Solo injury accident: On April 18, 2016 1:37 AM a 23 year old Pinole resident fell asleep driving e/b on Refugio Valley Road below the football field. Her Toyota Camry drove onto the center Island and struck a tree. The Camry then re-entered the roadway and drove over the opposite curb striking a road sign and a tree. The female was transported to Kaiser Vallejo with leg pain and had some bleeding on her forehead.

Natural Death: On April 18, 2016 at 10:29 a.m. an officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Regatta Point for a possible Coroner's Case. A 79 year old female was found, unresponsive, in her bed. Rodeo-Hercules Fire located the female in a downstairs bedroom. Fire pronounced the female deceased at 10:33 a.m. There was no indication the death was suspicious; and the female suffered from several medical issues. The CCCSO Coroner's Deputy released the body to her family.

Miscellaneous Information: On April 18, 2016 at 5:13 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to a disturbance at Big Lots. The reporting party said a male suspect just destroyed some bags of potting soil. An officer located the juvenile subject at the BART Transit Lot. Big Lots Management decided they didn't want to prosecute the juvenile. He was admonished and released. His mother was notified.

Unlawful Sexual Contact with a Minor: On April 18, 2016 at 4:37 p.m. an officer was dispatched to a telephone detail regarding possible unlawful sexual contact with a minor. The incident reportedly occurred, somewhere in the Foxboro development, on 04/17/16. A CCCSO Deputy was with the 15 year old female victim, and her Grandfather. The Grandfather contacted CCCSO after discovering her texting photos of herself to an 18 year old male. The victim reportedly met an 18 year old male yesterday, in Hercules. The victim stated she and the male had consensual sex in Foxboro Park, and in Rodeo. The victim was transported to the County Regional Medical Center, by a parent, for a formal medical exam. The investigation is ongoing.
