Court Order Violation: On May 12, 2016 at 11:13am an officer was dispatched to the 1200 block of Willow for a report of a restraining order violation. The restrained person went to the protected person's residence in violation of a domestic violence protection order. He was gone when officers arrived.

Traffic Collision/Info Exchange Only: On May 12, 2016 at 4:01pm, officers were dispatched to the intersection of Willow and Hawthorne regarding a two car collision. Both parties declined medical treatment. The officer facilitated the exchange of information.

Outside Assist for CHP – Freeway Shooting: On May 12, 2016 at 10:36 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to E/B I-80, between PVR and Hercules, for a roll-over vehicle collision. Dispatch advised the vehicle involved in the collision had an occupant with a gunshot wound. CHP was not on scene and asked HPD to respond. HPD officers controlled the crime scene until CHP arrived and shut E/B I-80 down, at PVR, to conduct their investigation. Hercules Officers assisted for a short time before clearing.

Auto Burglary: On May 12, 2016 at 10:38 p.m. an Officer was dispatched to Burger King, 836 Willow Ave. to take an auto burglary report. The reporting party parked his '00 Chev Suburban in the parking lot in front of Burger King. The Suburban had the right front passenger window shattered by an unknown suspect. The auto burglary occurred between 8:00 p.m. and the time of call.

Lost/Stolen Plate: On May 13, 2016 at 8:20am a resident from the 1200 block of Willow Ave reported his front license plate was lost/stolen sometime between March 1, 2016 and May 9, 2016.

Warrant Arrest: On May 13, 2016 9:27am officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Ben Lomond for a report of a suspicious vehicle occupied by two adults. Officers contacted the occupants. 28 year old Timothy Tillman Mcenge, of Sacramento had a no cite misdemeanor warrant out of Solano County. Mcenge was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Auto Burglary: On May 13, 2016 at 11:01am an officer was dispatched to 3600 San Pablo Ave for a report of a window smash of a Toyota 4Runner. The suspect was described as a female associated with a blue BMW. The reporting party parked his vehicle in the parking LOT in front of Starbucks. While inside the coffee shop he was advised, by another customer, that a female had just smashed his window and took his backpack. The backpack contained the victim's Apple MacBook air, wallet, and \$15 in cash. At about 1:00pm the victim was advised San Pablo PD arrested two females for auto burglary in San Pablo. The suspects were in possession of property belonging to the victim. Hercules PD will follow up on the case.

Warrant Arrest: On May 15, 2016, at 6:30pm an officer checked a vehicle near Victoria Park. The occupant, 45 year old Angel Garcia, had a no bail felony warrant, held by HPD. Garcia was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol: On May 14, 2016 at 6:29 a.m. an officer checked on a report of a disabled vehicle blocking the roadway on San Pablo Ave. at John Muir Parkway. The officer located a Black '99 Infiniti G20 stopped in the #2 lane of S/B San Pablo Ave. South of John Muir Parkway. The vehicle had damage to the right front axle/wheel and there were pieces of the right front tire in the roadway. Officers saw scuff marks on the west curb of San Pablo Ave. at John Muir Parkway where the vehicle collided with the curb. The officer contacted the driver, 27 year old Ryan Vivian, who displayed objective symptoms of alcohol intoxication. Vivian was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test, but refused to blow into the Preliminary Alcohol Screening device. Vivian was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. He was cited out to his Mother.

Warrant Arrest: On May 14, 2016 at 9:43am, an officer stopped a vehicle in the 1500 block of Sycamore for a vehicle code violation. The driver, 49 year old Eric Joe Staudinger, had two misdemeanor bench warrants, and one felony bench warrant, for his arrest. Garcia was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility

Petty Theft: On May 14, 2016 at 10:30am officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Sycamore for a report of an auto burglary that just occurred. It was later determined to be a petty theft. The reporting party said he had

an argument with his girlfriend. The girlfriend entered his truck took his backpack.

Traffic Collision: On May 14, 2016 at 10:56am, officers were dispatched to a non-injury collision in the 1200 block of Willow Ave. The driver of vehicle one lost control of his vehicle and crashed into two park cars just prior to 1231 Willow.

Warrant Arrest: On May 14, 2016, at 6:07pm, an officer stopped an Audi, at Zeus and Apollo, for a traffic violation. The driver, 25 year old Chad Wolfgang Sales, had a no cite misdemeanor warrant. Sales was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Resisting, Delaying, Obstructing a Peace Officer/Felony Evading/DUI:

On May 14, 2016 at 6:49 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Manzanita Place for a report of an out of control 25 year old male. An officer arrived and located the male in the driveway. The male displayed objective symptoms of extreme alcohol intoxication. The subject refused commands to stop. The subject took off his shirt and started walking towards one of the officers. The subject continued to disobey verbal commands to stop. The subject's father grabbed him by his shoulders and was trying to push him into the garage. The subject broke free and ran to the driver's side of a Gray '14 Toyota RAV 4 parked in the driveway. The subject got into the driver's seat, backed out of the driveway, and drove away. Officers order the subject to stop but he drove down Manzanita Pl. at a high rate of speed. The CCCSO Helicopter was in the area and gave updated locations of the vehicle. An Officer was on Sequoia Rd, at Lupine Rd, and saw the vehicle driving towards him. The Officer began a vehicle pursuit but the driver failed to yield. The driver drove over the center median (Lupine Rd. at Sycamore Ave.) and drove E/B in the W/B lanes of Sycamore Ave. The driver of the vehicle almost collided with another vehicle while making a wide left turn from Sycamore Ave. onto Palm Ave. The suspect vehicle collided with the barrier along the right side of Palm Ave. The subject voluntarily stopped the vehicle, exited the driver's side, and got down on the ground. 25 year old Christopher Sarmiento was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol; Felony Evading Arrest; and Resisting and Delaying a Police Officer. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated Sarmiento was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol: On May 14, 2016 at 9:10 p.m. an officer did a traffic stop on S/B Willow Ave. just South of Cambridge St. The driver, 45 year old Saan Saechao of Richmond, exhibited objective signs & symptoms of being under the influence of alcohol. The subject

performed the Standard Field Sobriety Test, but was unable to complete the use of the Preliminary Alcohol Screen Device. Saechao was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Saechao was later cited and released to his Wife.

Death Investigation: On May 15 2016, at 09:41 a.m., Rodeo Hercules Fire District requested an officer responded to a residence in the 1400 block of Partridge where Fire personnel had been dispatched for a stroke victim. Shortly after RHFD's arrival, the 69 year old victim passed away. The subject suffered from several medical ailments and the Coroner's Office released the body to his family.

Criminal Threats/Violation Of Probation (Domestic Violence)/Violation of a Court Order: On May 15, 2016, at 4:33 p.m., a resident in the 1000 block of Harbor Point came to HPD and reported her ex-husband told her nephew, and her father, he had "two loaded rifles and was going to shoot her". 59 year old Harinder Khahera was later arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Vehicle Theft and Recovery: On March 15, 2016, at 8:44pm, a resident from the 100 block of Meadowlark called and stated her 1998 Toyota had been stolen. She last saw the vehicle on May 12, 2016, when she left on vacation. When she returned today the vehicle was gone. The reporting party found the vehicle parked in the 1200 block of Tigger Ct, in Rodeo. A HPD officer took the theft and recovery report.

Public Intoxication: On May 16, 2016, at 4:18pm an officer was dispatched to the report of a female lying on the sidewalk, in the 800 block of Alfred Nobel. The officer located 36 Nukza Muanza lying on the sidewalk. She displayed the objective signs of alcohol intoxication. She did not have any one to care for her so she was arrested for Public Intoxication. She was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Non-injury Hit & Run: On May 16, 2016, at 10:33 a.m., a resident in the 100 block of Daisy reported someone hit his parked car sometime last night.

Domestic Battery & Warrant Arrest: On May 16, 2016, at 3:00 p.m., a female called from Refugio Valley Park and said while she was arguing with her daughter's' father and he threw a cup of ice water at her which struck her face. She did not have any visible injuries although she complained of minor pain on the left side of her face. She declined prosecution. 38 year old Tyler Swartz was located by the tennis courts and arrested for an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Residential Burglary: On May 16, 2016, at 5:26 p.m., a resident in the 200 block of Agate reported someone broke into his residence through a rear window sometime today. Cash and a computer were missing from the house.

Misdemeanor Warrant arrest: On May 17, 2016 at 1:52 AM an officer contacted 30 year old Cravan Sturgis, of San Pablo, walking in the shopping center at 844 Willow Ave. Sturgis was determined to have a no cite warrant. Sturgis was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Automobile Burglary: On May 17, 2016, at 1:47 p.m., a citizen reported his Toyota Rav4 was broken into sometime today while it was parked at the Franklyn Canyon Golf Course. A checkbook and a portable CD player were missing from the car.

Identity Theft: On May 17, 2016 at 7:56 PM a Hercules resident reported being the victim of identity theft. She said on or about March 1, 2016 she received a letter stating she opened an account with a current balance of \$2,000. The reporting party stated she had never opened an account with that company. The company cleared the account and sent her an affidavit to complete, which she did. On 5/10/16 she received another letter from the company stating that the investigation was ongoing. The reporting party decided she should complete a theft report so she called HPD.
