Theft by False Pretenses: On June 8, 2016 at 10:14am an officer was dispatched to the police department for a lobby detail. The elderly victim reported she was scammed out of \$10,000. She sent two blank checks to an unknown person in southern California who called her asking for financial help.

Petty Theft: On June 8, 2016 at 12:14pm an officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Salt Spray Terrance for a report of a theft. The victim reported that sometime last night, an unknown suspect stole her Richmond Sanitary trashcan from in front of her residence.

Residential Burglary: On June 8, 2016 at 1:43pm officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Sparrow regarding a residential burglary. The victim reported that sometime after 7:30am this morning an unknown suspect gained entry into her home and stole three televisions and one PlayStation. Entry was made through the side garage door, by breaking a window on the door and unlocking the door.

Probation Violation (Alcohol Consumption) and Warrant Arrest: On June 9, 2016 at 3:53am officers were dispatched to Willow Avenue at Canterbury for a report of a vehicle collision involving a dark Blue Chevy Monte Carlo. The reporting party told Dispatch the Monte Carlo was stopped on the sidewalk with the engine running with no one around. When officers arrived they located the vehicle stopped on Canterbury partially on the sidewalk. The Monte Carlo was occupied by 46 year old Jeannine Nelsen, from San Pablo. Nelsen told officers she consumed one alcoholic beverage earlier and couldn't explain how she ended up stopped on the sidewalk. Nelsen was found to be on Misdemeanor DUI Probation and was found to have two outstanding misdemeanor arrest warrants. Nelsen was arrested and transported to Martinez Detention Facility.
