Warrant Arrest/Possession of Controlled Substance: On June 6, 2016, at 8:00am an officer checked on a suspicious occupied Nissan Altima in a parking lot in the 800 block of Willow Avenue. There were two occupants in the vehicle, 23 year old Joshua Knoell from Pittsburg, and a transient female. Knoell had three outstanding warrants for narcotic related charges and .4 grams of a controlled substance (suspected methamphetamine) and drug paraphernalia (glass pipe) were located in the vehicle. Knoell was arrested for the warrants and the narcotics and transported to Martinez Detention Facility. The female was released with her vehicle.

Petty Theft from Vehicle: On June 6, 2016, at 9:38am an officer was dispatched to a lobby detail regarding a theft. The victim from the 2000 block of De Anza said sometime between June 5, 2016 at 9:30am and June 6, 2016, at 8:00am someone entered his unlocked Toyota Tacoma and took his keys and key fob for his 2002 Mercedes and a portable speaker. The Tacoma was parked on the street in front of the residence.

Found Property: On June 6, 2016, at approximately 2:19pm, a resident from the 200 block of Bobolink came to the police department to turn in an India passport which he located in his 33 year old son's room. The passport was listed as lost property from Vallejo PD and the investigation continues.

Stolen Vehicle: On June 6, 2016, at 5:14pm an officer was dispatched to Davenport Court for the report of a vehicle theft. Sometime between June 3, 2016 at 4:30pm and June 6 at 4:30pm a green 1997 Nissan Maxima four door, CA license plate 3WBC600, was taken from Worchester Court.

Occupied Stolen Vehicle and Possession of Narcotics: On June 6, 2016 at 7:05pm a resident from S. Arbor called Dispatch and stated that her transient son (33 year old Matthew Jurgensen) was currently in her vehicle, which she had reported as stolen to CHP earlier today. Officers

were updated that her son left again in the vehicle. Officers located Matthew driving out of the area and completed an enforcement stop on Trellis Bay, arresting the lone occupant. While completing a search .9 grams of suspected Methamphetamine was located in the center console and determined it to belong to Matthew. Matthew was transported to Martinez Detention Facility and the vehicle was returned to the owner.

Battery with No Prosecution: On June 6, 2016 at 7:37pm 31 year old Gilbert Short from Hercules called from the 3000 block of San Pablo Avenue to report that his roommate, 68 year old Jimmy Bowman got into a fight on the bus while it was in transit. Both subjects were contacted and talked to. This is the second fight in a week over \$500 dollars Bowman believes Short stole from him. Neither subject wanted prosecution so officers mediated the disagreement. Both subjects live in a care home in the 200 block of Meadowlark and contact was unsuccessfully attempted with the care home owner.

Mail Theft and Vandalism: On June 6, 2016 at 7:59pm a resident came to the police department to report that 10 days of mail was stolen from the mailbox in front of her residence, in the 1500 block Swallow Way. The victim reported she has a locking mail box but the suspect damaged the door and accessed the mail. She added that her neighbor has security video footage of the theft and will bring in a copy of the video depicting the theft. The victim said the suspect, a heavysset male in a minivan, stole her mail at 12:06pm on June 3, 2016.
