Commercial Burglary: On June 23, 2016 at 8:04pm, an officer was dispatched to 4000 Alfred Nobel (Bio Rad) for a report of a burglary. The Security Manager reported between 2:30am this morning and time of call, unknown suspect(s) shattered an office building window, entered the building and stole seven laptops.

Found Property: On June 23, 2016 at 11:12am, a citizen turned in a set of keys found on Santa Fe Street. The keys were logged into evidence as found property.

Mental Health Evaluation: On June 23, 2016 at 12:18pm, officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of Sycamore for a welfare check on a 35 year old female adult cursing at workers. An officer located the female in the 3200 block of South Front Street. It was determined the female met the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. She was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

Non-Injury Hit and Run Collision: On June 23, 2016 at 2:25pm, an officer was dispatched to San Pablo Ave. The female driver of a Chevy Sedan said she was rear-ended by a male driver of a Ford pickup. After the collision, the male motioned to the female to pull over to the shoulder. As the female was pulling over, the male drove around her and fled the scene.

Traffic Collision On June 23rd 2016 at approximately 7:00PM HPD units were dispatched to the area of San Pablo Ave and Sycamore Ave for a traffic collision. A 1993 Honda Prelude and a 2015 Ford Fusion were involved in the collision. The 53 year old female, driver of the Ford, complained of pain to her left arm. She was transported to Richmond Kaiser.

Runaway Juvenile On June 23rd 2016 at approximately 7:04PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 3100 block of South Front St for a runaway. The 15 year old female was last seen on June 22, 2016, at approximately 2:00pm, when her father dropped her off at the Hercules Library. The female has prior runaway incidents. The juvenile was entered into Missing and Unidentified Persons System and a flyer was sent out to surrounding agencies.

Warrant Arrest On June 24th 2016 at approximately 1:24AM HPD units were dispatched to a disturbance in the area of Valley Run and Arete Ct. Officers contacted a 37 year old male and an 18 year old female. The female, Amanda Marlene Arvey of Vallejo, had a non-citable warrant out of Solano County. She was placed under arrest and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Felony Evading/Stolen Vehicle/Probation Violation/Warrants On June 24th 2016 at approximately 4:52AM a HPD Officer located an occupied stolen vehicle (1993 Honda Civic) in the 800 block of Willow Ave. The vehicle fled eastbound on I-80 and started to drive westbound on to oncoming traffic. HPD units did not pursue the vehicle once it started to drive the wrong way. The vehicle turned back eastbound on I-80 and HPD re-engaged the pursuit of the vehicle eastbound on I-80. The vehicle turned around at Cummings Skyway. And went westbound on I-80. The driver took the Hercules off ramp and went southbound on to San Pablo Ave, then eastbound onto Sycamore Ave. The pursuit terminated in the area of Sycamore Ave and Palm Ave as the driver lost control of the vehicle and spun out into a ditch. The driver, 30 year old Jeremy Lorenzo Duke of Fairfield, was taken into custody without incident. The pursuit lasted approximately 5 miles a reached a top speed of 90 MPH.

Duke had 4 outstanding warrants for his arrest; and is currently on probation for Auto Theft and other charges. The vehicle was confirmed stolen out of Oakland PD. Duke medically cleared and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Mail Theft: On June 24, 2016 at 8:38am, an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Emerald Way for a report of mailbox tampering. Reporting Party said on Wednesday June 22, 2016 between 11:30am and noon, she went to her locking mailbox and retrieved her mail. The following day, at approximately the same time, she went to check her mailbox and found 3 of the 4 mailboxes in the same cluster with the door open. She decided to report the incident today. The locking levers on the mailbox doors appeared to have been tampered with.

Lost/Stolen Plate: On June 24, 2016 at 10:20am, a resident from the 200 block of Oriole Ct reported the rear license plate of his 2002 Honda

missing.

Sex Registrant Violation: On June 24, 2016 at 11:38pm, officers were dispatched to the area of Coronado St. / Refugio Valley Rd. for a report of an adult male consuming alcohol in a parked vehicle. Officers located the male, sitting in a parked car. 36 year old Robert Joseph Novaresi was determined to be a sex registrant, per 290 PC and was out of compliance per conditions of his registration requirements. His registration expired in April of 2016 and he has not renewed. Novaresi was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Traffic Collision: On June 24, 2016 4:53pm an officer was dispatched to San Pablo Ave and Sycamore Ave for a report of a non-injury, two car collision. The officer helped facilitate an exchange of information.

Traffic Collision: On June 24, 2016 at 5:00pm an officer was dispatched to Sycamore at Redwood for a two car non-injury traffic collision. The involved vehicles were a black BMW and a white Toyota pickup. The driver of the pickup was cited for driving while unlicensed and uninsured.

Vandalism: On June 25, 2016 at 8:17 a.m. an officer was dispatched to McDonald's, 1570 Sycamore Ave. to take a vandalism report. The reporting party stated there was fresh graffiti to the Men's bathroom that occurred within the past 30 minutes.

Prisoner Pick-Up: On June 25, 2016 at 11:00 a.m. a Prisoner Transport Volunteer responded to San Francisco County Sheriff's Office to pick-up 21 year old Sammy Lopez, of Vallejo. Lopez was arrested on our outstanding Misdemeanor Warrant issued on 01/30/2015. Lopez was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Grand Theft: On June 25, 2016 at 5:12 p.m. an officer was dispatched to 100 block of Finch Ct. to take a report of a theft. The theft occurred 20 minutes earlier, in the parking lot of Lucky, 1590 Sycamore Ave. The male suspect contacted the victim via Facebook and they agreed to meet in the parking lot of Lucky to conduct the transaction. The male suspect asked to look at the two pairs of Air Jordans and victim gave the suspect the two shoe boxes with shoes. The suspect walked to the rear of his vehicle (Tan SUV) stating he was going to get his money to pay the victim. The male then got into the passenger seat of the SUV and the female drove off out of the parking lot E/B Refugio Valley Rd. The SUV was last seen near Country Run. An area check was done but the SUV was not located. The male was described an African American; in his 20's; approximately 6'4" tall; 250 lbs; short hair; wearing a blue and white T-shirt. He had tattoos, and a mark on his face. There was no detailed description of the African

American female. The Facebook account, the suspect used to communicate with victim, was already be deleted.

Mental health Evaluation: On June 26, 2016 at 8:09 PM Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Sheffield for a female screaming and cussing. The yelling was loud enough to cause the neighbors to call on her. When officers approached the residence they could hear the 56 year old female screaming. The female was determined to the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. She was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Possession of a Narcotic Paraphernalia: On June 27, 2016 at 3:44 AM an officer conducted a security check of Victoria Park. The officer observed 30 year old Florentine Pelayo of Oakland, and his 10 year old son, crossing the tracks after fishing. Pelayo was determined to be on searchable probation for drug sales. The officer conducted a search of Pelayo and his back Pack. The officer found a glass pipe, commonly used to smoke narcotics. Because the suspect had his son with him he was cited on scene for Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia and Probation violation.
