Warrant Arrest: On June 28, 2016, at 4:27 pm, an officer stopped a white Pontiac Grand Am, at 4000 San Pablo Avenue, for an inoperable third brake light. The driver, 19 Malik Cannon of San Pablo, had an outstanding misdemeanor arrest warrant out of Vallejo PD. Cannon was taken into custody and transported to Martinez Detention Facility.

Outside Assist: On June 28, 2016 at 8:11 PM an officer assisted Pinole PD in checking the Bar None parking lot for a 7 Series BMW driven by a possible kidnapping suspect. The vehicle was not located. Later the officer saw a black 750 BMW, driving onto Tara Hills Dr. The Passenger, and driver, fit the description of the possible female kidnap victim and male suspect. The officer stopped the vehicle and determined the female was not a crime victim. The male was arrested, by Pinole PD, when a gun was found in the vehicle.

Solo non-injury accident: On June 29, 2016 at 1:43 AM Hercules units were dispatched to Sycamore Ave. at Tsushima for the sound of an accident. Upon arrival we found a light pole down and a street sign bent over at the corner of Sycamore Ave at North Front. The responsible 20 year old male adult was located in the 1000 block of Promenade.
