**Public Intoxication** On August 4<sup>th</sup> 2016 at approximately 8:53PM a HPD Officer conducted a pedestrian stop on a subject who was having difficulty walking in the area of San Pablo Ave and Linus Pauling Dr. During the course of contact the officer determined Sandeep Singh of Hercules was unable to care for himself due to his level of intoxication. Singh was arrested and transported to the hospital for observation and cite/released.

**Shop Lifting and Battery** On August 4<sup>th</sup> 2016 at approximately 11:34PM an officer was dispatched to Home Depot for subject who was taken into custody by loss prevention for shop lifting. Richard Hovorka of Vallejo ran out of the business with merchandise and was apprehended by loss prevention. A struggle ensued and Hovorka punched one of the loss prevention officers in the face. Hovorka was transported to the Hercules Police Department and cite released.

**Assault with a Deadly Weapon/Felony Vandalism** On August 5<sup>th</sup> 2016 at approximately 6:21AM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 300 block of North Wildwood for annoying/harassing phone calls. While enroute dispatch advised that a possible vandalism was occurring. When officers arrived they contacted the victim who stated that his ex-girlfriend's current boyfriend had broken out the windows of his 2002 Nissan Altima with a baseball bat. During the investigation it was determined the suspect arrived at victim's house and attempted to hit him with a baseball bat. Suspect then used the baseball bat to break out the windows of victim's car. The suspect left the area, prior to police arrival, in a gold 1992 Honda Accord.

**Domestic Violence** On August 6<sup>th</sup> 2016 at approximately 9:34PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Coronado Way for a fight between a husband and wife. Upon arrival, it was determined that the husband had left the scene. The victim stated she did not desire prosecution.

**Stolen Vehicle:** On August 7, 2016 at 7:12 p.m. an officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Cinnabar to take a stolen vehicle report. The reporting party said an unknown subject stole his silver 2003 Honda Accord. The resident's surveillance camera showed the vehicle being stolen at about 4:00 a.m. on August 6, 2016, shortly after being parked.

**Mental Health Evaluation:** On August 7, 2016 at 5:27 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Lilac Circle for a report of a suicide attempt. Reporting party stated a family member ingested several pills. Officers arrived along with Rodeo-Hercules Fire and contacted all parties on scene. The victim was transported to the hospital to Contra Costa Regional Medical Center by ambulance.
