Identity Theft (BobCop): On October 3, 2016 at 12:19 p.m. a supervisor processed an online report regarding an identity theft. The Hercules resident stated she received a letter in the mail from PayPal Credit advising they detected suspicious activity on her account. The reporting party has never opened a PayPal account nor did she authorize anyone to do so on her behalf. PayPal Credit said an unknown suspect opened the account using her name and personal identifying information.

Ammunition turned in for destruction: On October 3, 2016 at 2:30 p.m. an Officer handled a lobby detail. The citizen turned in Shotgun shells, and rifle rounds for destruction.

Lost Property (BobCop): On October 3, 2016 at 5:09 p.m. a supervisor processed an online report regarding a theft. The reporting party, from the 100 block of O'Neil Circle, stated on August 23, 2016 he placed an online order for electronics. He never received his package. He checked with retailer and was told his order was mistakenly shipped to his old mailing address in Moraga. The package has not been located.

Petty Theft (BobCop): On October 3, 2016 at 5:45 p.m. a supervisor processed an online report regarding a theft. The reporting party, from the 2000 block of Pheasant Drive, stated on September 25, 2016 he left his Silver GoPro 3 camera lying on his parked car. A Vallejo resident stated that he parked and locked his vehicle, at 3700 San Pablo Ave, at 6:00PM. He went to Starbucks and Kinder's before returning to his car at 8:00 PM. He found his right rear passenger window was smashed and his computer bag was missing.
