Unlicensed Driver/Towed Vehicle – False Tab: On October 10, 2016 at 3:21 p.m. an officer conducted a traffic stop on Willow Ave. at Hawthorne Dr. The rear license plate on the vehicle was displaying a false 2017 year tab. The driver was a 26 year old female out of Rodeo. She was cited and released at the scene.

Non-Injury Vehicle Collision: On October 10, 2016 at 5:06 p.m. officers responded to Hercules Ave. at Santa Fe St. for a report of a two vehicle collision.

Negligent Discharge of a Firearm: On October 10, 2016 at 5:08 p.m. an officer responded to the 100 block of Cardoza St. for a suspicious circumstance. The resident reported finding both a bullet hole and bullet fragment in the side of his house. The bullet hole was consistent with a bullet being fired in the air from an unknown location and landing in the side of the house. There is no timeframe for when this occurred. The resident just noticed the bullet hole today and hasn't heard any shots being fired recently. The bullet fragment was collected, submitted in to evidence and photos were taken.

Stolen License Plate: On October 10, 2016 at 6:08 p.m. an officer responded to the 10 block of Peak Ct to take a report for a theft of a rear license plate that was stolen sometime between 8:30 p.m. last night and 7:15 a.m. this morning. The vehicle was parked in the visitor parking area when the theft occurred.
