Auto Burglary: On October 25, 2016 at 7:08 a.m. an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Maple Ct. to take an auto burglary report. The reporting party stated an unknown suspect shattered the right front window of a Blue '06 Dodge Charger sometime between 10:30 p.m. and the time of call. The interior of the Charger was ransacked, but nothing appeared to be missing.

Obstructing, Delaying, or Resisting a Police Officer: On October 25, 2016 at 9:20 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Tanager Way for a report of a possible domestic violence incident. The reporting party said nothing physical was happening, but her son's girlfriend was in the backyard crying. Officers arrived and could hear a female crying/yelling in the backyard. Officers contacted a 36 year old male at the front door. The male was advised the officers were investigating a Domestic Violence call and they needed to check on the welfare of the crying female. The male was requested to submit to "modified pat search", for weapons, due to the nature of the call. The male initially complied, but tensed up and resisted the Officer when he stated to pat search him. The male pushed backwards attempting to pull away from the officer. Damien Herrera was arrested for obstructing, or delaying the officer during an investigation. Officers contacted a 34 year old female, in the backyard. She was upset and was crying. She stated she had not been assaulted, but agreed she should leave the house for a while. Herrera was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility..

Lost Property – Wallet: On October 25, 2016 at 9:16 a.m. an officer handled a lobby detail regarding a lost wallet. The reporting party stated he last saw his Black Leather Thursday, October 20th. He thinks he may have lost his wallet somewhere between getting gas in El Sobrante to returning home to Hercules.

Auto Burglary x 2: On October 25, 2016 at 10:06 a.m. an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Lapis Ct. to take an auto burglary report. The reporting party said his two vehicles both had the right front passenger window's shattered. The first vehicle was parked facing south on Lapis Ct., a Blue '08 Mercury Mountaineer was parked in front of his house. The second vehicle, a Tan '00 Mercury Grand Marquis, was parked in the open visitor parking area in the court. Both vehicles had the glove boxes opened. However, nothing appeared to have been taken. The burglaries occurred sometime between 12:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. today.

Disorderly Conduct – Drunk in Public: On October 25, 2016 at 3:56 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the area of Sycamore Ave. at Civic Dr. for a suspicious subject.

The reporting party saw an adult male, outside the Library. The reporting party said the male had a bottle of wine and was drinking the wine from a cup. Officers arrived and saw the described male, seated on the ground, at the park next to the Hercules Library. He had a small glass cup which appeared to contain wine. Officers contacted the male and he exhibited objective symptoms of being under the influence of an alcoholic beverage. 62 year old Donald was arrested for Drunk in Public and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Petty Theft: On October 25, 2016 at 2:55 p.m. an Officer was contacted by Home Depot Loss Prevention at the Martinez Home Depot store. Loss Prevention stated they had a 56 year old male, in custody, for a theft from their store. The suspect admitted to taking a DeWalt reciprocating saw (Valued at \$299) and a DeWalt Hammer Drill (Valued at \$379) from the Hercules Home Depot store. The theft occurred today at 11:24 a.m. The theft was verified via Hercules' Home Depot's video surveillance cameras. Hercules Home Depot, did not report this theft. Martinez P.D. booked the male for their case. A case was taking for the Hercules loss.

Forgery check fraud: On October 25, 2016 at 6:47 PM a Hercules resident came to HPD to report a fraud. She stated an unknown person used her checking information to create false checks and then cash them without her permission.

Auto Burglary: On October 25, 2016 at 9:09 PM an officer was dispatched to the 800 block of Willow Ave for an auto burglary. The officer contacted the El Segundo resident who stated he parked and locked his Kia Sportage at 7:15 PM. When he returned to his vehicle, at 9:09 PM, he found the rear window shattered and his Dell laptop and Bose headphones missing.

Outside Assist for Violation of a Court Order: On October 26, 2016 at 5:45 AM a Hercules resident reported being the victim of a court order violation. She stated that she has a no contact order against her ex-

husband who lives in Charlotte, North Carolina. She stated that he has been sending her emails with the last one received on Monday October 24. This is a violation of the court order. The report will be forwarded to Charlotte PD.
