Vandalism: On October 27, 2016 at 7:13 am an officer responded to the 2000 block of Refugio Valley Rd. for report of vandalism. The reporting party stated an unknown suspect wrote graffiti on the wall in the men's bathroom at the location.

Vandalism: On October 28, 2016 at approximately 4:57 a.m. an officer was flagged down by a citizen while conducting a security check in the 3600 block of San Pablo Ave. The victim stated that someone had broken out the rear passenger window of his vehicle while parked in the 100 block of Boxwood Lane. No entry was believed to have been made into the vehicle and the victim was unsure if anything was taken at the time of this report.

Warrant Arrest: On October 28, 2016 at 8:20 am, officers responded to the 100 block of Ivy Bay on a suspicious person call. The caller reported that he saw a white male adult looking over a back fence of one of the homes in the area. The subject was said to be associated with a black SUV. Officers located a black SUV parked near the corner of Ivy Bay and Watermark. The SUV was occupied by 33 year old Matthew Jurgensen. Jurgensen was found to have a misdemeanor warrant for violating a court order. Jurgensen was arrested and transported to the Main Detention Facility.

Stolen Vehicle: On October 28, 2016 at 1:33 pm an officer responded to the 1600 block of Sycamore Ave for a stolen vehicle report. The victim reported that sometime between 12:00pm and time of call an unknown suspect stole his gray 1998 Nissan truck.

Fighting: On October 28, 2016 at 3:35 pm, an officer responded to the 2000 block of Refugio Valley Rd regarding a fight between a couple of juveniles.

Mental Health Evaluation: On October 28, 2016 at 5:57 pm officers responded to Florence Court for a welfare check. A female adult was contacted and transported to Contra Costa Regional Medical Center for evaluation.

Warrant Arrest: On October 28th 2016 at approximately 10:31 pm an officer saw a subject he recognized as 24 year old Lateef Omari seated in a vehicle in the 3600 block of San Pablo Ave. A records check revealed that he had a warrant out for his arrest. The vehicle had left the scene prior to the warrant being discovered but the officer located the vehicle and Omari in the area of Lookout Ct. He was taken into custody without incident and he was cite/released at the scene.

Probation Violation: During the above mentioned stop, 49 year old Darin Jensen of Crockett was seated in the front passenger seat of the vehicle. He was determined to be on probation. He was cited and released at the scene for a probation violation.

Recovered Stolen Vehicle: On October 29, 2016 at 10:45am, an officer located a stolen vehicle in the 1900 block of Redwood. The vehicle was towed for safe keeping.

Petty Theft: On October 29th 2016 at approximately 6:53 pm an officer responded to the 100 block of Staples Ct for a theft report. The victim stated that she had some workers clean the attic and garage. She noticed that several items were missing from the garage after the workers left. The missing items were a dinnerware set, humidifier, and vacuum cleaner.

Court Order/Probation Violation: On October 29th 2016 at approximately 10:49 pm an officer responded to the 2000 block of Lewis St for a suspicious person. Upon arrival officers located 36 year old Sidney Holter III lying on the ground. It was determined that Holter was in violation of a court order. He was cite/released on scene due to being transported to the hospital for a medical issue.

Non-Injury Collision: A vehicle swerved to avoid fresh paint and collided with two trees. There were no injuries.

Warrant Arrest: An officer observed 48 year old Donald Gachis of Napa, loitering in the parking area on Lupine Drive. A subsequent contact and query of Gachis, revealed he had an outstanding warrant. Gachis was arrested and transported to the Main Detention Facility in Martinez.

During his evidence search the officer located a loaded firearm. Whaley was transported to the Hercules Police Department for testing and then transported to Main Detention Facility.
