Non-Injury Vehicle Collision: On November 2, 2016 at 8:49 a.m. an officer was flagged down by a citizen in the 3600 block of San Pablo Avenue who advised of a 3 vehicle collision on Willow Avenue near the Park & Ride.

Non-Injury Vehicle Collision: On November 2, 2016 at 9:53 a.m. an officer responded to the 1600 block of Sycamore Avenue for a report of a non-injury vehicle collision.

Hit and Run Collision: On November 3, 2016 at 7:19am an officer responded to the 1300 block of Sycamore for a report of a traffic collision. The reporting party stated that sometime after 6:30 last night, an unknown suspect hit her vehicle and another vehicle causing minor damage. There is no suspect information.

Recovered Stolen Vehicle: On November 3, 2016 at 9:57am, an officer located an unoccupied stolen vehicle in the 1500 block of Sycamore Drive. No suspects were located.

Suspected Child Abuse: On November 3, 2016 at 11:09am, an officer took a report for suspected child abuse.

Miscellaneous: On November 3, 2016, during the recovery of the stolen vehicle officers observed a suspicious vehicle and contacted all occupants including an adult male identified as Victor Hernandez. Hernandez was taken into custody regarding a separate case where he was identified as the suspect in a stolen vehicle. He was interviewed at Hercules PD and later transported to the Main Detention Facility in Martinez.

Traffic Collision: On November 3, 2016 at 2:46pm, an officer responded to the 900 block of Sycamore regarding a non-injury accident involving a city vehicle. The city employee was backing out of a parking stall and hit a parked vehicle.

Seized License Plate: On November 3, 2016 at 5:47pm, an officer checked on a suspicious vehicle in the 3700 block of San Pablo Avenue. The vehicle had two different plates attached. The registered owner was contacted, the front plate confiscated and returned to DMV.

Assault with a Deadly Weapon and Attempted Burglary On November 3rd 2016, at approximately 8:59PM officers responded to the 1500 block of Partridge Drive for a report of a subject in the backyard that was attacking one of the residents. The suspect, 45 year old Vincent Hernandez of Hercules fled prior to officers arriving. Hernandez attempted to break into the victim's trailer when he was confronted by the victim. A physical altercation ensued and during the struggle the victim was struck on the face with a cane by Hernandez. During an area check Hernandez was located, taken in to custody and was transported to the Main Detention Facility in Martinez.

Identity Theft: On November 4, 2016 at 8:00am, a victim made an online report of identity theft in the 200 block of Scotts Valley.

Traffic Collision: On November 4, 2016 at 8:21am, officers responded to Sycamore and Civic regarding a two car collision. One occupant was transported to the hospital by ambulance as a precaution.

Auto Burglary: On November 4, 2016 at 8:32am, an officer was flagged down in the 100 block of Civic Drive for a report of an auto burglary which occurred in the 3700 block of San Pablo Avenue. The victim entered the store and upon returning to his vehicle he discovered the right rear window was shattered. Taken from the vehicle were two laptops and a cellphone.

Auto Burglary: On November 4, 2016 at 11:22am, an officer responded to the 1200 block of Willow for a report of an auto burglary. The victim discovered that the right front window had been shattered. Taken from the vehicle was an IPAD and a car seat.

Warrant Arrest: On November 4, 2016 at 4:18pm, officers responded to Peak Ct for a report of three males loitering in the area. Four males were contacted at Peak and Pinnacle Ct. One of the males, Cornell Miller was found to have warrants. He was taken in to custody without incident and transported to the Main Detention Facility in Martinez.

Identity Theft: On November 5, 2016 at 11:32am, an officer was dispatched to Pinnacle Ct for a report of identity theft. The victim reported that someone used an old address of hers to apply for a credit card.

Mental Health Evaluation: On November 5, 2016 at 3:18pm, officers responded to the Police Department and contacted a subject who the officers determined wanted to cause harm to herself. She was transported to the hospital for evaluation.

Driving Under the Influence and Child Endangerment: On November 5, 2016 at 10:05pm, an officer conducted a traffic stop and contacted 38 year old Baljit Kaur, of Hercules on San Pablo Ave at Hercules Ave. It was determined that Kaur was driving under the influence. There was a juvenile passenger in the vehicle. Kaur was arrested for DUI and child endangerment. The juvenile was released to a family member and Kaur was transported to the Main Detention Facility in Martinez.

Petty Theft: On November 5, 2016 at 10:27pm, a citizen reported a suspicious unknown black male in the 100 block of Paradise. He also wanted to report the subject as a suspect in the theft of his son's bike from 2 weeks ago. Officers were unable to locate the suspect.

Probation Violation: On November 6, 2016 at 2:33am, officers responded to the 100 block of Paradise Drive for an unwanted subject kicking the door to the residence. Prior to arrival it was determined that the suspect was 44 year old Damon Dixon of Richmond and he was intoxicated. Upon arrival Dixon was located in the passenger seat of his vehicle with the seat reclined. A records check revealed Dixon was currently on probation. He was arrested and transported to the Main Detention Facility in Martinez for being in violation of the conditions of his probation.

Coroner's Case: On November 6, 2016 at 6:48am, officers responded to the 300 block of Lilac Circle for an unresponsive 89 year old female. The Coroner determined she died from natural causes.

Auto Burglary: On November 6, 2016 at 8:11am, an officer responded to the 300 block of Atlas for a report of an auto burglary. It was reported there was a second vehicle with a shattered window parked on Titan Way. The unknown suspect also unsuccessfully attempted to shatter the front passenger window. A jacket was the only item stolen from the interior of the vehicle.

Auto Burglary: On November 6, 2016 at 8:37am, an officer responded for another auto burglary on Titan Way. The victim found that the right rear passenger window of his vehicle was shattered. The unknown suspect ransacked the interior of the vehicle. However, nothing appeared to have been taken.

Vandalism to Mailboxes: On November 6, 2016 at 9:07am, an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Finch Court to take a report for a vandalism to a cluster of locked mailboxes. It is unknown at this time if any mail was stolen by the unknown suspect.

Auto Burglary: On November 6, 2016 at 12:59pm, an officer was patrolling in the ten block of Glenwood. The officer located a vehicle that had been burglarized. The left rear passenger window was shattered by an unknown suspect. The unknown suspect reached inside the vehicle and removed an empty messenger style lunch bag and a stuff sack containing a backpack rain cover. Both items were found lying on the ground beneath the shattered window.

Auto Burglary: On November 6, 2016 at 1:44pm, an officer responded to the 200 block of Titan Way to take an auto burglary report. Officers had located this victim vehicle earlier this morning and saw it had a shattered right rear passenger window. The victim stated the only item he noticed missing from the interior was his Black/Teal Makita drill combo set valued at \$400.

DUI: On November 6, 2016 at 3:36pm, officers responded to the area of Sycamore Ave. at Willow Ave. for a report of a reckless driver. The reporting party described the driver of the vehicle to be a Hispanic male adult. Officers located the vehicle in the 1700 block of Redwood Road and made contact with the driver, 50 year old Paul Basso. Basso appeared to be under the influence. He was placed under arrest, transported to the Hercules Police Department before he was transported to the Main Detention Facility in Martinez.

Interfering with a Police Officer and probation violation 1203.2: On November 7, 2016 at 5:32am, officers responded to the 800 block of Willow Ave for a report of a black male adult who was observed looking in to vehicles. The subject was identified as 24 year old Dylan Dotson of Hercules. Officers located Dotson at the scene. While attempting to identify him he took off running across Willow before he was detained by officers. Dotson was positively identified by the witness as the suspect in the parking lot. Dotson was taken in to custody and transported to the Main Detention Facility in Martinez.
