Unlawful us of an access card: On November 15, 2016 at 10:27 a.m. an Officer handled a lobby detail regarding an unlawful use of an access card. The Hercules resident said she found an unauthorized charge to her Macy's American Express card.

Carrying a concealed Dirk or Dagger on Person/Possession of Drug Paraphernalia: On November 15, 2016 at 11:15 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 76 gas station, 828 Willow Ave. for a report of a disturbance. The reporting party said an adult male, and adult female, were in a verbal altercation with another adult male, who had a Black colored puppy. The reporting party stated the first male knocked a plate of food out of the hands of the other male. Officers located the male, with the puppy, seated near the 76 gast. The other two subjects were not located. 29 year old Jeremy Robbins (transient) was determined to be on searchable probation. He had a large knife in his left boot. Robbins was also had a glass pipe, commonly used to smoke narcotics, and a small amount of Marijuana. Robbins was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The puppy was turned over to Animal Control.

Non-Injury Vehicle Collision: On November 15, 2016 at 5:03 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the area of San Pablo Ave. at Victoria Crescent West for a report of a hit and run vehicle collision. The reporting party said he was just sideswiped by a Silver '00 Honda Civic. The reporting party was following the driver of the Civic as she continued to drive down Parker Ave, towards the Rodeo Post Office, on two flat tires. The driver of the Civic stopped in the parking lot of True Value Hardware on Parker Ave. Officers drove past the location of the original vehicle

collision, on the way to the True Value Hardware. Officers observed a vehicle had recently collided with the center median along N/B San Pablo Ave. south of Victoria Crescent West. There were visible tire marks on the center median. Officers contacted the reporting party in a Silver '13 Toyota Avalon. The Avalon had sideswipe damage to the right rear quarter panel. The 67 year old female driver of the Civic was contacted and seemed disoriented. She said knew she hit the center median, but had no idea she had two flat tires or hit another vehicle. The Civic's left side wheels sustained moderate damage and both left side tires were flat.
