Stolen Vehicle: On December 5, 2016 at 7:37 a.m. an Officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Dartford St. to take a stolen vehicle report. The reporting party said an unknown suspect stole his Tan '97 Honda Accord at 7:40 p.m. last night. When the reporting party realized his vehicle was missing he reviewed his home's video surveillance footage. The camera captured the theft of his Accord. The footage showed an adult male walk down Dartford St, from Brighton St, and looked into his Accord. The suspect opened the driver's door (possibly left unlocked), started the vehicle, and drove away. The Accord had Marine Corps stickers in the back window.

Petty Theft (BobCop): On December 5, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. a supervisor handled an online police report regarding the theft of a Christmas decorations. The reporting party lives in the 2000 block of Railroad, and stated sometime overnight an unknown suspect stole her new Christmas light decorations from her front yard.

Forgery/Passing a Forged Check: On December 5, 2016 at 10:41 a.m. an officer handled a lobby detail regarding a check fraud. The reporting parties recently discovered an unknown suspect cashed a fraudulent check, using their B of A business checking account's information. The fraudulent check was cashed in Keyes, CA.

Attempted Passing of a Forged Check: On December 5, 2016 at 2:35 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to Bank of America, 1611 Sycamore Ave. for a report of an attempted check fraud that just occurred. The reporting party stated a Hispanic male adult, in his 20's, attempted to cash a fraudulent check. The suspect took his identification and fled in a newer model Black Chrysler last seen towards Taco Bell. An Officer contacted the Bank Manager who showed her the stolen personal check the suspect left. The Officer contacted the victims (father & son) who stated an unknown suspect recently stole their joint checking account check book from their house during a Wedding reception.
