Lost Property: On November 30, 2016 at 10:59 a.m. an officer handled a lobby detail regarding lost property. The Rodeo resident reported losing her California Driver's License at Big Lot's.

Recovered stolen Vehicle: On November 30, 2016 at 11:50 PM Pinole Police picked up a LoJack signal for a stolen 2008 Honda Element. They tracked the hit to Hercules Ave, at Village Parkway. Pinole discontinued their search due to a priority call. A Hercules Officer, with LoJack equipment, picked up the directional signal. The officer located the Honda Element, unoccupied, in the 200 block of Scotts Valley Rd. The Element was reported stolen to Sacramento Police on 11/30/16. No Suspect was located. The vehicle was towed and the license number removed from the Stolen Vehicle System,

Possession of a stolen vehicle/ Possession of stolen property/three Auto burglaries & one petty theft from a vehicle: On Dec 1, 2016 at 4:14 AM Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 400 block of Grenadine for three suspicious subjects looking into cars. An officer was at Mandalay at Grenadine and observed three individuals, dressed in dark clothes, run towards Cayman. The officer gave chase but lost sight of the individuals as they turned on to Cayman. Other officers searched the area and located a 17 year old male, from Richmond; and a 16 year old male, from Hercules, walking on Catalina. The males were not out of breath and did not appear to be the subjects chased by the officer. The juveniles were released. Officers continued searching for the original three subjects. A short time later an officer located the two juveniles, from Catalina, sitting in a Chevy Suburban on Aruba Ct. A check of the vehicle showed it had been

reported stolen, from El Cerritio, on November 22, 2016. Both juveniles were placed under arrest for being in possession of the stolen vehicle. Officers located stolen property, in the vehicle, from auto burglaries that occurred in Hercules last night. Confirmed thefts, at this point, are from the 100 block of Vierra; the 400 block of Grenadine; the 200 block of Palermo; and the 100 block of Caprice Circle. The Juveniles were transported to Juvenile Hall.
