**Warrant Arrest/Felony Probation Violation/Bringing a Controlled Substance into the Jail:** On December 6, 2016 at 8:01 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to 200 block of Brighton St. for a possible prowler. The resident stated an African American adult male, wearing a blue hoody, was looking in his window. A resident, Lancaster, called in stating he had seen a subject, matching the description in his backyard. Officers were searching the area, when a Detective contacted an adult male, matching the suspect's description, in the 300 block of Newbury St. The subject's pants were wet and his sneakers were muddy. This was consistent with going through backyards and greenbelts. 44 year old Rashaan Wadley was found to have a outstanding Felony warrant. He was arrested on that warrant. Officers found a pipe, containing a small amount of Marijuana, on Wadley's person. Before Wadley was taken to the Martinez Detention Facility, he was asked if he any other contraband and he said he did not. When he was searched, at the jail, the Deputy found additional drug contraband.

**Outside Assist – BART P.D. (Auto Burglars detained):** On December 6, 2016 at 10:27 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to a report of suspicious persons at the BART Transit Lot, 1375 Willow Ave. A Security Guard saw a suspicious an African American male, and female, loitering near vehicles in the parking lot. A HPD officer located a male and female, juvenile, matching the Security Guard's description, leaning against a Toyota Camry. The officer observed the left rear wing window of the Camry was shattered with glass shards lying on the ground below. The interior of the Camry also had broken glass on the rear passenger seats and was ransacked. Items, possibly stolen from interior of the Camry, were found

lying on ground underneath the vehicle, and the male had a fresh cut on his left hand consistent with cutting himself while breaking a window. The case was turned over the BART Police for further investigation.

**Petty Theft of Mail/Forgery:** On December 6, 2016 at 6:10 p.m. an Officer was dispatched to a mail theft and forgery of checks. The resident, from the 100 block of Fuscia Ct, stated he had his bank checks mailed to his home, but never received them. He was then notified by his bank that the missing checks had been cashed.
