Lost Property: At On December 16, at 8:20am, a School Resource Officer took a lost property report from a high school faculty member. The reporting party said he lost laptop computer.

Warrant Arrest: On December 16, 2016, at 10:27am, Officers were in the 800 block of Mariners Point and observed and 29 year old Tiffany Nurss. Nurss was found to have a no cite warrant issued on 12/14/16. Nurss was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Traffic Collision: On December 17, 2016 at 1:04pm, officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Violet for vehicle vs. motorcycle collision. The motorcyclist sustained minor abrasions and declined medical attention. The vehicle had minor damage and the motorcycle had major damage.

Robbery: On December 17, 2016 at 1:13pm, an officer was dispatched to Home Depot for an in custody theft suspect. Officers contacted the reporting party who stated he saw 50 year old Frank Denbae select three combo drill kits and place them in a shopping cart. The reporting party watch Denbae walk out the emergency doors, of the Garden Area, passing all available cashiers. The reporting party identified himself as "Loss Prevention Officer" (LPO) and told Denbae to come back in the store. Denbae violently resisted being detained. Denbae attempted to hit the LPO in the face. The LPO was able to subdue Denbae and walk him to the LP office.

Traffic Collision: On December 17, 2016 at 3:00pm, officers were dispatched to the Willow at Canterbury for a non-injury collision.

Stolen Vehicle: On December 18, 2016 at 6:12 AM Hercules Police was dispatched to an in progress vehicle theft. A stolen 1992 Gray 4 Dr Honda Accord was being driven towards Windsor from the area of 500 Bristol. The suspects were described as two Hispanic males with beanies. They were associated with a white panel van, unknown what make or model. We were unable to locate the Honda or Van.

Misdemeanor Warrant Arrest: On December 18, 2016 at 10:01 PM an officer stopped 47 year old Dana Matthews, of Walnut Creek, on State Route 4 at San Pablo Ave for expired registration. During the stop it was learned Matthews had a no bail warrant. Matthews was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Occupied stolen vehicle: On December 18. 2016 an officer was contacted a citizen who was tracking a cell phone. The citizen said the cellphone was in her vehicle, which was stolen in San Pablo. The citizen had not reported the vehicle stolen. The reporting party said her ex-boyfriend, 35 year old Jason Rivera stole her vehicle. The officer took a stolen vehicle report. The Officer had contact with Rivera, earlier in the evening. Rivera was cited for driving without a license. The vehicle was not listed as a stolen, and the Registered Owner could not be contacted, so it was towed. The officer located Rivera and arrested him for Auto Theft. Rivera was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
