Auto Burglary x 2: On December 14, 2016 at 7:51 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the parking lot of Starbucks, 3700 San Pablo Ave. for a report of two auto burglaries that occurred within the past five minutes. A Silver Porsche, and a Black Honda, were the victim vehicles. The suspect vehicle was seen leaving the parking lot, and was described as a Black Mercedes CLS 500 with Green/White paper plates. Officers contacted the owner of the '99 Porsche Carrera and observed the driver's side window had been shattered. The owner's Black/Gray Puma backpack was stolen. The second victim was standing near her Black '02 Honda CRV. The CRV had the right front passenger window shattered. An "Ivanka Trump" tote bag was stolen. A witness saw an African American adult male breaking the driver's side window of the Carrera. The witness yelled at the suspect and he ran to the CLS 500 parked next to the CRV, get into the driver's seat, and drive away. The suspect was described as having facial hair; short cropped curly hair; wearing a Black hooded sweatshirt, White t-shirt, and Black pants

Homicide: On December 14, 2016 at 5:22 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the Glenwood Condo complex. The reporting party stated a female just ran someone over and they were unresponsive. The witness stated the female driver was leaving the scene in a Silver vehicle. Officers located the victim lying in the parking lot. Officers checked the victim and he was found to have a faint pulse, but was not breathing. Rodeo-Hercules Firefighters from Station 76, along with an AMR Paramedic Unit, arrived to medically evaluate the victim. The victim was pronounced deceased at 5:38 p.m. Witness told the officer an adult female, in a silver or grey vehicle, was driving circles in the parking lot. When the witnesses got

closer, to the car, they saw a male was being dragged under the car. The male's body was dislodged from the vehicle and the female driver fled out of the complex.

The investigation showed the victim, and the suspect, lived in separate residences, in the complex. Further the couple had a dating relationship. Today the couple had a dispute which ended with the female running over the male, then leaving the scene. The suspect vehicle, a 2003 Altima, was abandoned, on Village Parkway, near the entrance to Glenwood. At approximately 8:30pm the suspect, 19 year old Desire Borela, turned herself in to Detectives, at the Hercules Police Department. Borela was arrested for Second Degree Murder and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The victim was identified as 22 year old Ian Irby.

Hit and Run Vehicle Collision: On December 14, 2016, at 6:30pm an Officer was dispatched to Rite Aid for a report of a cold Hit and Run. The officer contacted the reporting party who stated an unknown Asian female collided with her vehicle, while making a left turn from S/B San Pablo Ave on to E/B Sycamore Ave. The suspect vehicle is described as a dark colored 4 door sedan. The vehicle failed to stop and was last seen east on Sycamore Ave.

Stolen Vehicle: On December 15, 2016, at 7:41am an officer responded to the 1000 block of Rock Harbor for the report of theft of a Silver 2003 Ford E350 van. Reporting party said he parked the van in front of his residence last night around 8:30pm. When he returned this morning at 6:30am it was gone.

Petty Theft: On December 15, 2016, at 1:45pm, an officer responded to the 100 block of Riverview Terrace, for a theft of a package, which occurred within the last two minutes. The suspects were described as a Hispanic male adult driver, and a Hispanic adult female passenger, with long brown hair in a ponytail. They were associated with an older model white four door vehicle. The reporting party said she was standing in her kitchen when she noticed the female pick a package that was left at her front door. The female got into the passenger seat of the vehicle. The suspects and vehicle were last seen driving north bound on Tsushima from Riverview Terrace.

Flooding: Willow between the transit lot and Palm was closed due to flooding. Public Works was notified and will be out to clear the drains in the area tomorrow

Theft On December 15th 2016 at approximately 7:23PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Crestridge Dr for theft of a package. The reporting party said a package was taken from his front porch sometime between 1:30PM and 5:00PM.

Recovered Stolen Vehicle On December 15th 2016 at approximately 9:03PM a HPD Officer located an unoccupied stolen vehicle in area of Claeys Ln and Sycamore Ave. The gray 1997 Ford Ranger was reported stolen to Vallejo PD on 12-15-16. The driver's door and ignition were punched out.

Hit and Run Collision On December 15th 2016 at approximately 9:29PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Titan Way for a hit and run collision. The suspect vehicle, a silver VW collided into multiple parked vehicles and the driver was no longer on scene. No description of the driver was provided. An area check was conducted but no suspect(s) were located.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol: On December 16th 2016 at approximately 12:55AM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop, on a silver 2005 Honda Civic, in the area of Sycamore Ave and Lupine Rd. The driver, 27 year old Jeff James Carillo, displayed the objective symptoms of being under the influence of alcohol. Carillo was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated Carillo was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. He was placed was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. He was cite released to a responsible party.
