Recovered Stolen Vehicle: On December 27, 2016 at 9:03 a.m. an officer located a Gray '92 Honda Accord he knew to have been reported as a stolen vehicle, to our agency, on December 18th. The Accord was located parked in the visitor's parking area of the Willow Glen Apartments. The interior of the Accord was ransacked and the car stereo was removed/stolen.

Theft by False Pretenses: On December 27, 2016 at 12:59 p.m. officers were dispatched to a lobby detail regarding an identity theft. The reporting party said she responded to a "virus alert" on her home computer and called the phone number associated with this fraudulent alert. She allowed a "technician" to remotely access her home computer under the guise of "fixing" the "virus." "The "technician requested the victim's bank account number and routing number in order to "pay" him to fix the "virus." The victim later learned she had over \$400 deducted from her account. The victim contacted the "company" and was told they couldn't refund the loss since she authorized the payment.

Possession of less than One Ounce of Marijuana: On December 27, 2016 at 1:59 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the area of Chelsea at Dover for a report of a suspicious vehicle. The reporting party stated there were two adult males, smoking Marijuana, in a light colored sedan. Officers located the sedan still parked in the carport space with 2 male occupants. A strong odor of Marijuana was could be smelled coming from the interior of the vehicle. A probable cause search was done and a small plastic bag containing a green leafy material, believed to be Marijuana, was found underneath the driver's seat. The driver, 23 year old Phillip

Secrease of Pinole, didn't have a Medical Marijuana card. Secrease's Marijuana was seized and he was cited for Possession of Less Than One Ounce of Marijuana. The 20 year old male passenger was released with no charges.
