Vandalism: On December 21, 2016 at 8:29am, an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block Jacaranda Ct. for a report of vandalism. The reporting party said the rear window of his vehicle was shattered sometime between 2:30am this morning to time of call. This is the second time this week his vehicle has been vandalized.

Petty Theft: On December 22, 2016 at 10:53am, officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Willow for a report of a theft. The reporting party said an African American female adult stole \$180 in lotto scratchers. The female was last seen getting into a silver Honda Accord occupied by an African American male. The Accord was last seen south on Willow Ave\

Lost Property: On December 22, 2016 at 12:51pm, an officer was dispatched to HPD for a lobby detail. The reporting party said they lost their passports (Two). The passports was last seen a few months ago.

Burglary: On December 22, 2016 at 11:39am, officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Iris Rd. for a report of a residential burglary which occurred within the last hour. The point of entry was a shattered rear slider. The bedrooms were ransacked. The loss was cash. A neighbor reported hearing glass shattering between 9:30am and 10:00am.

Possession of a Controlled Substance and Probation violation On December 22nd 2016 at approximately 11:13PM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop, on a silver 1998 VW Passat, in the area of Vaqueros Ave and 7th Street. The driver, 32 year old Freddie Louis Edwin Lane Jr of El Sobrante, was discovered to be on probation out of Alameda County. A

probation search was conducted and a small amount of a substance, believed to be a narcotic, was found on the front passenger seat. Lane was placed under arrest and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Auto Burglary: On December 23, 2016 at 4:23pm, an officer was dispatched to 3500 Franklin Canyon Rd for an auto burglary. The reporting party parked his 2013 Toyota Highlander in the parking lot of the golf course at about 10:30am. When he returned to his vehicle he saw the left rear cargo window had been shattered. The suspect(s) stole a bag that contained a Nest Wifi Thermostat, a hat and jacket. The hat and jacket were recovered in the parking lot by another golfer and turned in to the Pro Shop.

The reporting party said, sometime last night, an unknown suspect stole a bike from the back of his truck. The truck was parked in front of the residence and has a Tonneau Cover. A neighbor said she saw the cover open at about 7:30am this morning.

Auto Burglary: On December 24, 2016 at 2:39pm, an officer was dispatched to 3500 Franklin Canyon Rd for an auto burglary. The reporting party parked his 2005 Lexus in the parking lot of the golf course at about 12:15pm. At 2:25pm, he returned to his vehicle and saw the left rear window had been shattered. The suspect(s) stole a briefcase with an IPAD inside.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol On December 24th 2016 at approximately 6:50PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of Sycamore Ave and San Pablo Ave for a subject who appeared to be asleep behind the wheels of a silver Scion. Officers located the silver Scion xB in the 100 block of Paradise Dr. The occupant, 33 year old Darnell Anthony Jones of Oakland, was contacted and displayed the objective symptoms of being under the influence of alcohol. Jones was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated Jones was over the presumptive limit, for the purposes of driving. He was placed under arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Jones was cite/released to a responsible party.

Occupied stolen vehicle: On December 25, 2016, at 1:21 pm, an officer checked on a silver 2004 Toyota Tacoma with a front license plate attached to the rear bumper. The vehicle was found to be occupied with an adult sleeper. The officer could see the ignition was punched. The male was detained and the vehicle was found to be cold plated. The VIN came back to a vehicle reported stolen to our agency on November 11, 2016. The occupant, 48 year old John Jewett, Transient, was arrested. Jewett is on probation for Auto Theft. Jewett had two credit cards, not belonging to him, in his possession. One of the credit card owners was contacted and confirmed the card was stolen from her unlocked vehicle December 17, 2016. Jewett was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility..

Misdemeanor warrant arrest: On December 25, 2016 at 8:29 PM an Officer stopped a vehicle, in the 4000 San Pablo Ave, for a headlight out. During the stop it was determined the driver, 25 year old Lateef Omari, had 7 outstanding Misdemeanor warrants. 5 Of the warrants were held by Contra Costa County; 1 in Santa Cruz; and 1 in Solano County. Omari was arrested for the outstanding warrants and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. He was also cited for driving on a suspended license.

Misdemeanor warrant arrest: On December 26, 2016 at 9:21PM an officer contacted 36 year old Vanessa Vargas, of Lower Lake California, in front of Willow Food and Liquor. During the contact the officer determined Vargas had a Misdemeanor Contempt Of Court Warrant issued by

Felony Domestic Violence: On December 27, 2016 at 1:51 AM Hercules units were dispatched to the 100 block of Grenadine for a domestic violence incident between boyfriend and girlfriend. The 21 year old female, of San Francisco, called Police. Officers determined the female got into a physical confrontation with her 32 year old boyfriend. The female was determined to be the primary aggressor as the male had scratches and bumps on his face and the female had no visible injuries.
