Outside Assist On December 29th 2016 at approximately 8:55PM HPD Officers responded to the 2400 block of Appian Way (Valero/7-11) to assist Pinole PD Officers with an armed robbery that had just occurred. HPD Officers assisted with a perimeter and area check but the suspect was not located.

Outside Assist On December 29th 2016 at approximately 10:43PM HPD Officers assisted CCCSO Deputies search for a subject wanted for felony domestic violence. The incident occurred in the 500 block of Vallejo Street, in Rodeo. The suspect was last seen in the area of Super Stop on Fourth S, in Rodeo.

Auto Burglary On December 30th 2016 at approximately 6:31AM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 3700 block of San Pablo Ave for an auto burglary that occurred within previous 5 minutes. A white 2000 Chevy Cavalier had a window smashed out. The loss was a black "Coach" laptop bag.

Residential burglary: On December 30, 2016 at 2:49pm, the resident from the 100 block of Aralia Ct reported a residential burglary. Sometime during the past two weeks, items have turned up missing from her home. No forced entry was located.

Found Property: On December 31, 2016 at 11:17 a.m. an Officer was dispatched to a report of a set of keys found near back gate entrance to the Hercules Police Department. The keyring appeared to have been lying in the dirt and some of the keys were rusted. There was nothing identifiable

to the owner on the keyring. The keyring and keys were placed into Evidence for Safekeeping.

Auto Burglary: On December 31, 2016 at 3:05 p.m. an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Dartford St. to take a report for a vandalism to a vehicle. The reporting party said an unknown suspect smashed the window of her 99 Green Saturn. The vehicle was parked in front of her house. The officer determined the suspect actually pried open the passenger door and unsuccessfully attempted to remove the car stereo. The incident occurred between 8:30 p.m. last night and 2:30 p.m. today.

Recovered Stolen Vehicle: On January 1, 2017 at 1:41 p.m. an Officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Chelsea to handle a recovery of an outstanding stolen vehicle. The reporting party said he found a Gold '94 Honda Accord parked in his carport. The Accord was reported as a stolen vehicle to CHP on December 31, 2016. The Accord was stolen from Coral Ridge Circle in Rodeo.

Officers arrested 42 year old Sarah Adnan on the Warrant out of Orange County. The Warrant was issued on 11/16/2016 Adnan was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Warrant Arrest/Driving on a Suspended Revoked Driver's License/Towed Vehicle:

On January 2, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. an Officer made a traffic stop, on a Gold '92 Honda Accord on N/B Willow Ave, for having tinted front windows. The driver, 40 year old Gerald Easterling of Vallejo, was driving on a suspended or revoked driver's license. Easterling was found to have two outstanding Misdemeanor No Bail Warrants out of Stockton P.D. The both warrants were issued on 05/20/2016. The victim was told to take a photo of the two Green Dot cards serial numbers and send the photos to the "seller." Once the "seller" received the serial numbers, he would contact the victim and

give the victim shipping information. The victim did not hear back from the “seller”, nor did he receive the ATV’s he thought he purchased.

Vandalism: On January 2, 2017 at 6:09 p.m. an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Fog Cutter Cove to take a report for a vandalism to a mailbox. The reporting party said an unknown suspect smashed his mailbox sometime between 12:00 p.m. yesterday and 12:00 p.m. today.

Possession of a Controlled Substance/Probation Violation:

The passenger, 42 year old Jaimee Ellam, was found to be on Contra Costa County searchable probation.
