Petty Theft (Bobcop): On January 3, 2017 at 11:56 a.m. a supervisor processed an online police report regarding a petty theft from the 100 block of Square Rigger Cove. The reporting party stated an unknown suspect stole 4 Christmas lights, from his front yard, sometime between midnight on 01/01/16 and 9:49 a.m. on 01/02/16. The stolen Christmas lights were valued at approximately \$30.00.

Brandishing a Knife/Criminal Threats/Probation Violation/Mental Health Evaluation: On January 3, 2017 at 12:05 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Watermark Terrace for a report of a disturbance. The reporting party said a 24 year old male just pulled a knife on his brother. Officers arrived and contacted the suspect's Father and Brother. The victim said his brother brandished a kitchen knife at him and threatened to kill him. The father said the suspect (his other son) was still inside the house and had locked himself inside an upstairs bathroom. Officers attempted unsuccessfully to have the suspect come out. A Crisis Intervention Trained officer responded and was also unsuccessful in attempting to get the suspect to come out of the bathroom. Officers ultimately forced entry into the locked bathroom and found the suspect lying in the bathtub. The suspect was determined to meet the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. He was transported, by ambulance to the County Regional Medical Center. At approximately 11:30pm, the suspect was medically cleared and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Storm Damage: On January 3, 2017, at 9:53pm Officers were dispatched to Pheasant Dr., at Swallow Dr. for a downed tree branch, partially blocking

the roadway. Officers were able to push the branch to the side of the roadway. Public Works was notified.
