SUMMARY		

On July 17, 2013 officers, from the Hercules Police Department, conducted a “Compliance Check” of twenty-one subjects listed as Sexual Registrants, and reported to be living in the City of Hercules by the California Department of Justice (per section 290 of the California Penal Code). None of the subjects listed are classified as “High Risk”.

Officers contacted ten of the subjects listed and determined they were in compliance with all the terms of their registration requirements. There was no response at seven of the addresses listed, and officers will attempt contact at a later time. Officers determined that four of the listed subjects have moved from the City of Hercules. That information will be submitted to the Department of Justice, and that subject’s names will be removed from the City of Hercules’ list.

Hercules residents who want to find out if a sexual registrant is living in their area may access “Megan’s Law” registrant information site, by going to the City of Hercules Website and selecting “Megan’s Law”. However, per DOJ guidelines, not all registrants are listed on the Megan’s Law site.

Hercules Police Department will periodically be conducting random “Compliance Check” for all subject listed as sexual registrants living in Hercules.
