WILLOW AVENUE AND PALM AVENUE ROAD CLOSURES BEGINNING MONDAY, OCTOBER 12 AND ENDING FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 20

Please be advised Willow Avenue Eastbound from the Hercules Transit Center to the Highway 4 Overcrossing is scheduled to be closed from Monday, October 12 to Friday, November 20 for road repairs. Willow Avenue Westbound from the Highway 4 Overcrossing to the Hercules Transit Center will remain open. Palm Avenue between Sycamore Avenue and Willow Avenue will also be closed in both directions during this time. A detour plan is attached for your use.


The road closures are necessary to repair Willow Avenue, which is severely deteriorated and must be completely rebuilt in order to handle the heavy traffic loading. The repair work is being completed by O.C. Jones from Berkeley, which was the low bidder on the project. The work is anticipated to cost \$775K and is being paid for with Gas Tax funds.

Please plan on using alternate routes while the road closures are in effect. We recognize the detours are an inconvenience and may require additional travel time. Please keep in mind they are necessary to complete the much needed repairs and Willow Avenue will be restored to a new condition once the repairs are completed.
