Suspicious Circumstance: On January 6, 2016 at 9:48am officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Regatta Pt. regarding a report of a male seen jumping the fence from a backyard. The caller from the 500 block of Garretson (Rodeo) reported seeing a male jumping the fence from the backyard of a house in the 1000 block of Regatta. The male was seen carrying a black garbage bag and a razor scooter. Officers checked the house on Regatta and found the side door to the main house unsecured. The residence was checked and no one was found inside. The homeowner returned to the home and confirmed nothing was missing from his house. Officers also checked the adjacent homes and no evidence of a crime was located.

The Hercules Police Department thanks of the Police Department and we cannot do our job without concerned citizens calling in when they see something out of the ordinary. It does not appear there was any crime committed, in this instance, but it surely needed to be checked out. Officers did find an unsecured door and alerted the home owner. A crime may have been prevented by the Police discovering the unlocked door before a criminal did.

Mental Health Evaluation: On January 6, 2016 12:09pm officers were dispatched to the 100 building of Dorado Court regarding an unwanted female. Officers contacted the 23 year old female sitting at the front door of the reporting party's residence. The female was crying, shaking, and rambling. The female was determined to meet the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. She was transported, by ambulance to the County Regional Medical Center.
