Lost Property: On January 7, 2016 at 11:00am an officer was dispatched to HPD for a lobby detail. The reporting party said yesterday she cashed a check at Chase Bank (3600 San Pablo Ave). She inadvertently left the cash on the counter at the bank. When she realized she had left her money, she returned to the bank to find it missing.

Mental Health Evaluation: On January 7, 2016 at 9:19 PM Hercules units were dispatched to the 100 block of Sheffield for a female banging on the door. Officers could not find the address given on Sheffield and began looking for the female. A second call came in regarding a disorientated female outside a house on Davenport. An officer located and contacted a 56 year old female. The female was determined to meet the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. She was transported by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

Warrant Arrest Felony Resisting Arrest and Giving False Information to a Police Officer: On January 8, 2016. At 10:02am, an officer stopped a gray Mercedes for a vehicle code violation. The right front passenger, a 25 year old male, stated he had a California identification Card. A records check did not yield a California License or a California identification Card for the subject. He then said he had a Texas driver's license and again no record was located. Officer conducted a fingerprint recognition scan determined the male to be 25 year old Vincent Lewis Harris. Harris had an extraditable warrant for his arrest out of the US Marshals Service, Arlington VA. While taking Harris into custody he became combative and physically resisted officers in their attempt to secure him in the backseat of a marked patrol car. During his resistance. Two officers sustained minor injuries during the struggle. One officer had a mild sprain to his left wrist and the other officer had a minor injury to his right hand. Lewis was arrested for Felony Resisting Arrest, Giving False Information to a Police Officer; and the Felony Warrant. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Court Order Violation: On January 8, 2016 at 1:23pm an officer was dispatched to Refugio Valley Park regarding a child custody issue. The reporting party was at the park to pick up his child, per a court order for visitation. The mother of the child fail to show up for the exchange again today.

Residential Burglary: On January 8, 2016, at about 10:42 pm, an Officer responded to a residence in the 100 block of Kensington Circle for a reported burglary that occurred between 8:00 am and the time of call. Officers determined that the point of entry was a smashed rear glass sliding door. As of now, the items missing include jewelry, a purse and cash.

The driver, 38 year old Wilder Oswaldo Cruz of Antioch, displayed objective symptoms of being under the influence of an alcoholic beverage. Oswaldo was administered Standard Field Sobriety test. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening Device indicated Oswaldo was over the presumptive limit, for the purposes of driving. Oswaldo was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. He was cited and released to a responsible party.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol: On January 9, 2016, at about 3:01 am, an Officer initiated a traffic stop, on a 2012 Nissan Altima, for a stop sign violation and DUI indicators. The driver, 22 year old Laura Mota of Hercules, displayed objective symptoms of being under the influence of an alcoholic beverage. Mota refused to perform the Standard Field Sobriety Test, and the Preliminary Alcohol Screening Device testing. She was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Mota was Cited and released to a responsible party.

The reporting party was again at the park to pick up his child, per a court order for visitation. The mother of the child fail to show up for the exchange again today

Domestic Violence: On January 9, 2016 at 1:54pm, officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Dartford Way for a report of a domestic violence incident. The responsible party was a 31 year old male from San Jose. The victim was contacted at the address. The suspect was located on Brighton/Edinburgh. The reporting party said the suspect twisted her arm and slammed her head against a wall, four times, creating a lump on her forehead. The suspect said the lump on the victim's head was self-

inflicted. A witness verified the reporting party's account. Paramvir Virk was arrested for Felony Domestic Violence and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

The credit cards were issued an El Cerrito resident. The owner was contacted and stated she had been a victim of an auto burglary, today, in El Cerrito. The purse was booked into property for safe keeping.

Upon arrival, Officers contacted an adult male subject sitting on the front porch. The subject began having convulsions and requested to be taken for a mental health evaluation. Warrant Arrest: On January 10, 2016 at 9:03 a.m. Hercules Officers went to the 100 block of Maple Ct and arrested. 31 year old Nohemi Perez for an outstanding Misdemeanor Warrant, issued January 7, 2016. Officers issued the subject a citation, with a new court date, and released her.

The victim did not have any visible injuries and declined to prosecute the female suspect. The female was advised to stay away from the condo.

Prisoner Transport: On January 10, 2016 at 11:03 a.m. a transport officer responded to Marin County Jail to pick up 36 year old Brandon Wells, of Vallejo, on our outstanding Misdemeanor Warrant. The Warrant was issued on 10/20/2015. Wells was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Petty Theft: On January 10, 2016 at 2:05 p.m. an supervisor processed an online police report regarding a theft from an unlocked vehicle. The reporting party, from the 1100 block of Earnest St stated, between 01/05/16 at 1:20 p.m. and 01/09/16 at 10:30 a.m., an unknown suspect gained entry into unlocked Green '13 Kia Soul that was parked on Earnest St. The suspect stole a garage door opener for the reporting party's detached garage and her Fast Trak transponder.

Lost or Stolen License Plates: On January 10, 2016 at 4:50 p.m. an Officer was dispatched to the 400 block of Lighthouse Ct. to take a report for stolen license plates. Reporting party said she parked her Silver '90 BMW 525i at the Richmond Marina today at 12:10 p.m. When she returned at 4:00 p.m. she noticed both license plates had been removed and stolen by an unknown suspect.

The reporting party gave the Officer an air rifle that belonged to his deceased son. The air rifle was taken back to the PD and entered into Evidence for destruction.

The reporting party said there were mailboxes opened on Weiss Ct. and O'neil Circle. The Officer contacted the reporting party who showed him his surveillance video showing an unknown race male or female opening mailboxes at two houses on Weiss Ct.. It is unknown if any mail was taken from the opened mailboxes.

Identity Theft: On January 11, 2016 at 5:17 p.m. an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Azalea Ct. to take an identity theft report. The reporting party said he received notices in the mail today regarding fraudulent credit card applications submitted, using his personal identifying information, without his knowledge.

Petty Theft / Possession of Stolen Property / Violation of Probation: On January 11, 2016 at 11:03pm an officer conducted a traffic stop, on a white Saturn Vue, with no license plate attached. The Saturn and did not have a temporary registration in the corner of the windshield. The officer contacted the adult male driver who said he was unlicensed. A records

check showed the driver did not have a driver's license and was on probation. The adult female passenger, in the right front seat, stated the male was driving the vehicle because of the trailer dolly attached. The passenger stated she recently purchased the vehicle. When she was asked for the paper work to the car she began looking through the car. The officer watched as she picked up a handful of mail from the floor board and tried to put it in the glove box. He asked her for the mail and saw that there were several pieces of mail addressed to several residents in the 1500 block of Partridge Dr, in Hercules. The officer asked where they got the mail and male said he found it on the ground and placed it into the vehicle and forgot to return it.

A second officer contacted 3 of the 6 owners of the mail and confirmed they were the victims of mail theft, and wished to press charges. 42 year old Richard Erickson, of Vallejo, was arrested for Possession of Stolen Property, and Violation of Probation. He transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. 54 Roseanna Harper, of Vallejo, was arrested for Petty Theft and Possession of Stolen Property. She was issued a citation and released.

Misdemeanor Warrant: During the above traffic stop the rear seat passenger, 44 year old Tanya Knight of Richmond, was found to have an outstanding warrant held by Contra Costa Sheriff's Office. She was arrested and released on a citation, with a new court date.
