**Found Property:** On March 17, 2016 at 6:58am an officer took a report for found property. The officer located a Magna 21 speed mountain bike on the roadway on Bayfront near Earnest. The bike was logged as found property at HPD.

**Identity Theft:** On March 17, 2016 at 9:34am an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Pearce for a report of identity theft. The reporting party said an unknown suspect took out a, in her name, without her permission.

**Found Property:** On March 17, 2016 at 9:34am an officer took a report for found property. The officer located a Raleigh Single Speed bike in the front yard of the 100 block of Pearce Street. The bike was logged as found property at HPD.

**Driving Under the Influence:** On March 17, 2016, at about 11:07 pm, an Officer made a traffic stop at Pheasant Drive and Starling, on a 2013 Honda Pilot, for a stop sign violation. The driver, 37 year old Isis Hunter Yee of Hercules displayed objective symptoms of being under the influence of an alcoholic beverage. Yee was administered the Standard Field Sobriety Test. The Preliminary Alcohol Screen device indicated Yee was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. Yee is on probation for DUI in Alameda County. Yee was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and transported the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Identity Theft:** On March 18, 2016 at 8:28am an Oakland resident submitted an online report. The reporting party stated someone used her name, and credit reporting information, on the lease agreement for a Hercules residence. She believes the suspect is someone she knows. The reporting party stated her signature on the lease agreement, was forged.

**Mental Health Evaluation:** On March 18, 2016 12:08pm officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Manzanita for a report of a subject with a knife had "Popped" the reporting party's tires. The reporting party said the suspect was her 24 year old sister. Later the reporting party said there was no damage to her tires. The female subject had reportedly left the knife inside a vehicle and walked away from the residence. Officers located the female walking westbound on Lupine Rd. Officers determined the female met the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. The subject was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

**Identity Theft:** On March 18, 2016 at 2:59pm an online report was received regarding identity theft. The reporting party said she had received an email from Life Lock inquiring whether or not she applied for a credit card, with Capital One, on March 14, 2016. She also received a telephone call from Capital One verifying the credit card was approved and mailed.

The same day the reporting party called and said she checked her credit report and saw a Hercules address, where she has never lived, listed on her credit report

**Weapon on School Grounds:** On March 18, 2016 at 2:42pm, a School Resource Officer (SRO) was called to the Assistant Principal's Office at the High School. A 17 year old male student had been seen with a knife on campus. The SRO found a medium sized, fixed blade, hunting knife in the student's back pack. The student was arrested and transported to HPD... He was later cited and released to his parents.

**Shoplifting:** On March 18, 2016 at 4:18pm an officer was dispatched to Home Depot for a report of a theft. A Loss Prevention Officers had detained 29 year old Joey Ray Bonnett, of San Pablo. The Loss Prevention Officer witnessed the suspect stealing products from the store. Bonnett was arrested for Shoplifting. He was cited and released at the scene.

**Warrant Arrest:** On March 18, 2016, at about 10:45 pm, an officer conducted a follow-up investigation regarding a theft of a package (reported on March 11, 2016 from the 1000 block of Gardenia Loop). The vehicle, associated with the theft of a package, was purportedly parked at the corner of Madeline and Montalvin. Officers located a 1998 Cadillac, and two subjects that were associated with it. One of the subjects, 44 year old Alexander Phillip Perez of San Pablo, said the vehicle was his. Perez was determined to have a felony warrant for his arrest. Perez was taken into custody for the warrant and transported to Martinez Detention Facility. Officers will do further follow-up on the theft case.

**Mental Health Evaluation:** On March 19, 2016 at 12:54pm officer were dispatched to the 1100 block Rock Harbor for a report of a physical altercation. The caller said his brother was acting out. Officers contacted a 17 year old male. The male was determined meet the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. He was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

**Hit and Run Collision:** On March 19, 2016 at 1:45pm an officer responded to the 1300 block of Willow for a report of a hit and run traffic collision. The collision occurred sometime around February 26-27, 2016.

**Vandalism:** On March 19, 2016 at 2:56pm an officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Bristol for a report of mailbox tampering. The reporting party said all the locks for the cluster of mailboxes had been pried open. No mail appears missing at this time. The mailboxes were intact yesterday. While the officer was contacting the reporting party from this incident, another neighbor reported the locks on her mailbox was also damaged overnight.
