Suspicious Circumstance – Domestic Violence Incident: On March 22, 2016 at 11:45 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched for a Disturbance occurring near Lucky, 1590 Sycamore Ave. The reporting party said an adult male and female were fighting. The male kicked the female and she was on the ground. Officers stepped up the response to code 3 and got there within minutes. Officers were flagged down by citizens who stated the couple just left W/B Sycamore Ave. Officers searched the area, but didn't locate the vehicle. A local Be on the Look Out was sent to surrounding agencies and CHP was notified.

Driving on a Suspended license /poss. of methamphetamine: On March 22, 2016 at 9:36 PM an officer stopped a Honda Civic, on the W/B I-80 on ramp from Willow Ave, for a non-functioning third brake light. The driver, 24 year old Sabrina Cross of Rodeo, was driving on a suspended license, and is on Felony probation with a search clause. Prior to searching the vehicle the officer had the passenger exit the vehicle. She was pat searched and the officer found a pipe, commonly used to smoke a controlled substance. The officer also found a baggie containing a substance believed to be a narcotic. 38 year old Viva Colwell was arrested for Possession of a Controlled Substance. The vehicle was searched and the officer found needle, filled with a substance believed to be a narcotic, behind where Cross (the driver) was sitting. Cross was cited for the suspended license and arrested for Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Violation of Felony Probation.

Missing Person: On March 22, 2016 at 11:51PM an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Marigold for a missing person. The reporting party said his his 15 year-old daughter was missing. He last saw his daughter at 7:30 AM on this date as she left for school. The juvenile has been reported missing multiple times and typically shows up to school on the next day. Megan was entered into the Missing and Unidentified

Persons System (MUPS). The juvenile was located, at school, at noon, March 23rd. She was removed from MUPS.

Vehicle Theft: On March 23, 2016 at 5:11 AM a resident from the 1200 block of Willow to report his tan 1998 4 Dr Nissan Maxima had been stolen. The vehicle was parked along the east curb, last night at 7:00 PM, and was missing this morning.

Warrant Arrest: On March 23, 2016 at 11:36 a.m. an officer observed a Green '00 Dodge Caravan, with expired registration (April 2014), in the parking lot of the Library. The officer determined the registered owner of the vehicle had an outstanding Misdemeanor No Bail Warrant, out of the National Parks Service in Yosemite, CA. The Warrant was issued on 07/21/2015. The officer got a picture of the registered owner and found him in the library. 57 year old Zhang Fakang, of Pinole, was arrested for the Warrant. The National Parks Service requested Fakang be given a new court date cite released.

Suspicious Device/Evacuation: On March 23, 2016 at 2:58 p.m. an adult male came to the front lobby of the Hercules Police Department. He had a bag containing what he said was a "fake bomb". The male said he found the device in an open field, across from the Shell Gas Station, at San Pablo Ave and Sycamore Ave. The male kept the device for a couple of months and today decided to bring it the PD. An Officer looked in the bag and saw what he believed could be an explosive device. The Officer, following appropriate protocol, evacuated the Police Department and City Hall. The Library and Senior Center were also evaluated. The Arbors, and Samara Terrace, senior apartment complexes were contacted and told to shelter in place. The Walnut Creek P.D.' Bomb Squad responded. The device was determined to not be an actual explosive device. The build was declared clear at 5:50pm and the shelter in place was lifted.
