Driving Under the influence of alcohol: On April 20, 2016, at about 10:27 pm, an Officer initiated a traffic enforcement stop on a 1997 Ford F150 in the 600 block of Parker Ave for DUI indicators. The driver, 67 year old Anthony Oscar Ruggiero of Rodeo displayed objective symptoms of being under the influence of an alcoholic beverage. Ruggiero was administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and at the conclusion, he was placed under arrest for DUI. Ruggiero was later cited and released.
