Theft from a vehicle: On June 13, 2016 at 2:24pm a resident in the 100 block of Orchid reported someone stole a pair of binoculars and loose change from his unlocked car between 3:00am and 5:00am today.

Suspicious Circumstance: On June 13, 2016 at 1:57pm an employee at a business in the 3700 block of San Pablo reported finding an unknown subject exiting from a restroom located at the rear of the business. The employee called the business owner, who called police. Video surveillance showed the subject opening the front door and quickly peeking around. At the time, all the employees were at the rear of the business. The subject entered the business and proceeded to slowly look around different work stations. He made his way to the rear where he entered a restroom and then exited the business. He was described as a B/M/A, about 25 years old, wearing a red baseball cap with #20 on it, black and white striped shirt and blue jeans.

Residential Burglary: On June 13, 2016 at 9:29pm a resident reported a residential burglary in the 1200 block of Canterbury. Entry was made by smashing the rear sliding glass door with an unknown object. It was determined only the master bedroom was ransacked and the loss was approximately \$8,000-10,000 in male and female jewelry.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Probation Violation: On June 13, 2016 at 11:01pm an officer stopped 32 year old Jerome Fronda, from Pinole, for driving through a stop sign at 35mph on Refugio Valley Road at Carson. A DUI investigation was conducted and it was also determined Fronda was on DUI probation. Fronda was arrested and submitted to a breath test with a result of .14bac. Fronda was transported to Martinez Detention Facility.

Vehicle Collision (Post Pursuit): June 14, at 1:27am, officers were dispatched to a vehicle collision behind a business in the 800 block of Willow Avenue. It was reported that the vehicle that had crashed had been pursued by CHP. It was determined the vehicle had initially been pursued by Vallejo PD onto I-80, when CHP picked the vehicle up at Cummings Skyway as it travelled w/b on I-80. The driver of the vehicle attempted to evade CHP and took Willow Avenue exit and attempted to hide to the rear of a business in the 800 block of Willow Avenue. The vehicle was found by the CHP Officer and the driver again attempted to flee, striking the cement block garbage structure and then struck the CHP vehicle. The driver continued to flee and crashed a final time in the parking lot, fled on foot, and is still outstanding. Contact CHP and Vallejo for additional information.
