The Hercules Police Department currently is sponsoring our **2016 Citizens Police Academy (CPA)**, beginning on Saturday, September 17th. This is our third year for CPA's and they are held on Saturdays from 8:30 AM to 3:30 PM, with graduation scheduled this year for November 5th.

Our CPA is open and at no charge to all who reside or work in the Hercules community and who are 18 years or older. Our Citizens Police Academy allows members of our community to learn about the day-to-day operations of a law enforcement agency. They will meet with and be instructed by officers currently involved in the maintenance of public safety in Hercules. They also will have instructors from other agencies, such the DA's Office, K-9 Unit, Bomb Squad, as well as through field trips to the Dispatch Center and the Martinez Detention Facility. Participants will be able to explore their interests in the law enforcement profession with officers in a more casual and positive setting. Questions about policies, procedures, and techniques of law enforcement could be asked and answered.

One of the most important reasons for attending our Citizens Academy is an opportunity to meet other members from our community with whom you will be able to interact, to take interesting field trips, and potentially to become a Police Department volunteer or Neighborhood Watch leader.

Seats are limited for the Citizens Police Academy.
