72 HR Psychiatric Commitment: On September 20, 2016 at 1:02 p.m. an officer observed a 75 year old female standing on the sidewalk on Willow Ave. She was crying and appeared to be upset. When the officer contacted her she told him she wanted to kill herself. She was transported to CCRMC by ambulance on a psychiatric hold.

Warrant Arrest: On September 20, 2016 at 2:19 p.m. an officer was in the area of Sparrow Drive when he saw 24 year old Bobby Moore of Hercules. The officer was aware that Moore had an outstanding felony no bail warrant. Moore's warrant was confirmed by Dispatch. Moore was arrested and transported to the Main Detention Facility in Martinez.

Lost Property: On September 20, 2016 at 3:37 p.m. an officer responded to the 500 block of Alfred Nobel Dr. to take a report for a lost wallet.

Found Property: On September 19, 2016 at 6:01 p.m. an officer responded to the Police Department lobby regarding a wallet and keys found on the walking path on Refugio Valley Rd. at Coronado St. The owner of the wallet was identified. The items were returned to the owner.

Vandalism: On September 20, 2016 at 6:09 p.m. officers responded to the 3500 block of Franklin Canyon Rd. for an unknown problem. When officers contacted the victim, he reported the driver's side window was shattered by an unknown suspect sometime between 1:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Nothing was left inside the vehicle and nothing was taken by the suspect.

Commercial Burglary: On September 20, 2016 at 8:42 PM officers responded to an in progress burglary in the 3700 block of San Pablo Ave. The reporting party stated a white male suspect smashed the window with a rock, entered the building and the exited with a glass case. The suspect was described as a white male adult in his 30's, 5-11, 250 with a beard.

Upon exiting the building the suspect walked across the lot to a waiting vehicle on San Pablo Ave. We learned the suspect vehicle was a 4 dr. Dodge, possibly an early 2000 black Dodge Charger. The driver of the vehicle was described as a white male adult in his 30's, 5'11" 250 wearing a white polo shirt. The witness stated the suspect vehicle turned left onto Sycamore Ave towards the water. We conducted a search of the waterfront with negative results. The glass case contained 40 Gucci glasses with a value of \$10,000. This case is still under investigation.

Misdemeanor warrant for DUI, and providing false information to an officer: On September 21, 2016 at 2:20 AM an officer conducted a traffic stop for a traffic violation on San Pablo Ave and Linus Pauling. The officer identified the driver as 37 year old Latasha McDonald of Antioch. McDonald verbally identified herself under an alias. The officer determined she was lying about her name and that she was driving on a suspended license for DUI. He also learned that she had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant and was on probation. McDonald was arrested and transported to the Main Detention Facility in Martinez.

Grand theft: On September 21, 2016 at 4:05 AM officers responded to the 100 block of Woodfield for a grand theft that just occurred. It was reported that a male suspect stole a Rigid camera from the rear of a truck. The camera is valued at \$14,000. The victim reported that the suspect vehicle was a rusted gray cargo van with at least one unknown race male. An area check was conducted with negative results.
