**Non-Injury Vehicle Collision:** On September 21, 2016 at 8:11 a.m. an officer responded to San Pablo Ave. at Sycamore Ave. for a vehicle collision. A Gray Nissan Altima was driving N/B San Pablo Ave. and rear ended a Tan '01 Toyota Sienna that exited the shopping center and was driving N/B San Pablo Ave. The driver of the Altima was evaluated by medical personnel and declined transport.

**Battery:** On September 21, 2016 at 11:14 a.m. an officer took a report for an assault that occurred in the 1900 block of Lupine Rd. A juvenile reported having been assaulted by a bus driver. This incident is still under investigation.

**Hit and Run Vehicle Collision:** On September 21, 2016 at 5:56 p.m. an officer responded to the 2100 block of Tsushima St. to take a report for a hit and run to a parked vehicle that just occurred. It was reported that responsible vehicle was a Green 2 door Toyota Tercel that had a dirty license plate. The Tercel collided into a parked Black Ford Fiesta and was last seen driving towards Sycamore Ave. The reporting party stated the Tercel is usually parked on Tsushima St. and they believe the driver lives in the area. The driver of the Tercel was described as either an elderly Asian or Hispanic male.

**Auto Burglary** On September 21<sup>st</sup> 2016 at approximately 8:38PM an officer responded to the 100 block of Ben Lomand for an auto burglary that occurred in the 3600 block of San Pablo Ave. The victim stated he parked his vehicle and entered a nearby business. Upon returning to his vehicle approximately 5 minutes later, he noticed that the left rear passenger window was smashed and his black backpack containing a Dell laptop and two Western Digital external hard drives were taken. No suspect information available at this time.

**DUI/Suspended DL** On September 21<sup>st</sup> 2016 at approximately 10:09PM an officer conducted a traffic stop on a gray 2013 Ram pick-up in the area of Willow Ave and Canterbury Dr. The driver, 42 year old Abasi Darnell Delley of San Pablo displayed the objective symptoms of being under the influence of alcohol. Delley was placed under arrest for suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol. He was also determined to be driving on a suspended driver's license. Delley was transported to the Police Department for a blood draw per his request. He was later cite/released to a friend.
