**Arrest Warrant:** On September 22, 2016 at 8:27am HPD Detectives executed an arrest warrant in the 200 block of Newbury. The warrant was in regards to a 2012 case involved suspected sexual abuse. The 66 year old Ricardo Soriano was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Miscellaneous Incident:** On September 22, 2016 at 9:06am an officer was dispatched to the 500 block of Alfred Nobel for a report of an employee being threaten by a patient yesterday. The reporting party said an adult male patient threatened to slap her yesterday. The reporting party did not want prosecution.
