

Notice Inviting Bids

- 1. Bid Acceptance.** The City of Hercules ("City") will accept sealed bids for its Community Center Pools Replastering Project ("Project"), by or before October 18, 2016, at 2:00 p.m., at the main counter at Hercules City Hall, located at 111 Civic Drive, Hercules, California, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

2. Project Information.

2.1 Location and Description. The Project is located at the Hercules Community Center at 2001 Refugio Valley Road, and is described as follows: replastering the 30,000 gallon wading pool and 300,000 main lap pool including emptying and refilling the pools, obtaining the necessary permits from the County Health Department and Pinole-Hercules Wastewater Treatment Plant, and all other associated work necessary to complete the project.

A guided tour and examination of the area to be serviced will be conducted on Tuesday, October 11, beginning at 10:00 am to answer any questions and review the proposed requirements. Vendors that are not able or do not choose to attend the tour and examination will be responsible for attaining all pertinent information regarding the requirements and specifications for the project.

2.2 Time for Completion. The planned timeframe for commencement and completion of construction of the Project is: Construction on the pool shall commence no earlier than December 19, 2016 and be completed by February 17, 2017.

3. License and Registration Requirements.

3.1 License. This Project requires a valid California contractor's license for the following classification(s): C-53 Swimming Pool.

3.2 DIR Registration. City will not accept a Bid Proposal from or enter into the Contract with a bidder, without proof that the bidder and its Subcontractors are registered with the California Department of Industrial Relations ("DIR") to perform public work under Labor Code section 1725.5, subject to limited legal exceptions.

- 4. Contract Documents.** The plans, specifications, bid and contract documents for the Project, and any addenda thereto ("Contract Documents") are available at www.blueprintexpress.com or by calling BPXpress Reprographics at (510)559-8299 or emailing Richmond@blueprintexpress.com.

- 5. Bid Security.** The Bid Proposal must be accompanied by bid security of ten percent of the maximum bid amount, in the form of a cashier's or certified check made payable to City, or a bid bond executed by a surety licensed to do business in the State of California on the Bid Bond form included with the Contract Documents. The bid security must guarantee that upon award of the bid, the bidder will execute the Contract and submit payment and performance bonds and insurance certificates as required by the Contract Documents within ten days after issuance of the notice of award.

6. Prevailing Wage Requirements.

6.1 General. This Project is subject to the prevailing wage requirements applicable to the locality in which the Work is to be performed for each craft, classification or type of worker

needed to perform the Work, including employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation, apprenticeship and similar purposes.

6.2 Rates. These prevailing rates are on file with the City and available online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR>. Each Contractor and Subcontractor must pay no less than the specified rates to all workers employed to work on the Project. The schedule of per diem wages is based upon a working day of eight hours. The rate for holiday and overtime work must be at least time and one-half.

6.3 Compliance. The Contract will be subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR, under Labor Code section 1771.4.

7. **Performance and Payment Bonds.** The successful bidder will be required to provide performance and payment bonds for 100% of the Contract Price.
8. **Substitution of Securities.** Substitution of appropriate securities in lieu of retention amounts from progress payments is permitted under Public Contract Code section 22300.
9. **Subcontractor List.** Each bidder must submit the name, location of the place of business, California contractor license number, DIR registration number, and percentage of the Work to be performed (based on the Base Bid) for each Subcontractor that will perform work or service or fabricate or install work for the prime contractor in excess of one-half of 1% of the bid price, using the Subcontractor List form included with the Contract Documents.
10. **Instructions to Bidders.** Additional and more detailed information about the Project and City's bidding requirements is provided in the Instructions to Bidders. All bidders should carefully review the Instructions to Bidders before submitting a Bid Proposal.
