**Suspicious Circumstance:** On October 18, 2016 at 6:50 a.m. officers responded to the 100 block of Grenadine Way. The reporting party stated she was warming her vehicle up in the driveway and went inside her house. When she returned to her vehicle she observed a Hispanic male adult, 6'0", bald, wearing a dark blue or black puffy jacket, seated in her driver's seat going through her vehicle. The reporting party confronted the HMA and he got out of the vehicle and was last seen walking towards Mandalay Ave. Officers checked the area, but were unable to find the suspect.

**Residential Burglary:** On October 18, 2016 at 11:02 a.m. officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Schooner Cove for a report of a residential burglary. When the victim returned home they found their rear sliding glass door broken and side garage door unsecure. Officers arrived and made entry into the home. When officers checked the residence they found a window screen that had been cut. Officers didn't find the rear sliding glass door shattered or any other damage. It didn't appear that entry was made by the suspect. The homeowner reported her iPad as missing.
