**Stolen Vehicle:** On October 19, 2016 at 7:25 a.m. an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Glenwood to take a stolen vehicle report. The reporting party said an unknown suspect stole his 2000 Silver Civic sometime between 6:30 a.m. – 7:30 a.m. this morning.

**Mental Health Evaluation:** On October 19, 2016 at 11:39 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the care home in the 1800 block of Redwood Rd. The reporting party said a 78 year old female resident assaulted a care employee as the resident was going AWOL. The female was last seen walking away down Redwood with a walker. Officers located the female on Redwood Rd. near Cedar Ct. The female met the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. She was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

**Residential Burglary:** On October 19, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. an officer handled a phone detail regarding a residential burglary. The reporting party lives in the 300 block of Pepperwood. October 16, 2016 at 3:26 p.m. the reporting party called the police regarding a possible residential burglary which occurred between October 15<sup>th</sup>, at 3:35pm and the time of call. She said when she got home, on the 16<sup>th</sup>, the upstairs bedroom window was open. The window was closed and the blinds were down when she left the previous night. Officers checked the house but didn't find any evidence of forced entry or a burglary. Today, the reporting party said she has discovered some of her electronic equipment, and jewelry, were missing.

**Identity Theft (BobCop):** On October 19, 2016 at 5:29 p.m. a supervisor handled an online police report regarding an identity theft. The Hercules resident stated that she was notified, by Wells Fargo Bank, an unknown suspect walked into their Palmdale, CA. bank branch and attempted to obtain a personal loan using her name and personal identifying information.

The reporting party has never banked with Wells Fargo Bank and didn't authorize anyone to use her name and personal identifying information.

**Court Order Violation** On October 19<sup>th</sup> 2016 at approximately 6:48PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Bobolink Way for a suspicious circumstance. The reporting party said someone knocked on his door and several moments later the power went out at his residence. Officers discovered the PG&E meter was missing from the side of the house. The reporting party said he received two voice messages, from his adult son, today which is in direct violation of a served court order. The reporting party thinks his son is also responsible for taking the meter box. The reporting party wished to press charges and he signed a Complainant's Arrest form.

**Supplement to Runaway Juvenile** On October 19<sup>th</sup> 2016 at approximately 9:32PM HPD Officer were dispatched to the 3100 block of South Front St for a family dispute. It was discovered the female juvenile was still listed as a runaway juvenile from (September 12<sup>th</sup> 2016). The family dispute was resolved and Juvenile was removed from MUPS.
