**Warrant Arrest:** On October 20, 2016 at 10:39am, an officer checked on an occupied vehicle in the 2200 block of Redwood. The lone occupant, 41 year old Joseph Balajadia of Vallejo, had a no-cite misdemeanor warrant out of Solano County. Balajadia was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Assault with a Deadly Weapon/Warrant Arrest/Brandishing an Altered BB Gun:** On October 20, 2016 at 5:12pm, officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Willow for a man with a gun call. The reporting party said an adult African American male, wearing a white shirt and black pants, was pointing a gun at her. An officer located the male at the entrance to 844 Willow. The male was holding what appeared to be a real hand gun at his side. When the officer contacted the male he dropped the gun and laid face down on the ground and was detained. The investigation indicated the male was walking southbound on Willow Ave. The male was was confronted by the reporting party, an adult female, who accused him of hitting her 18 year old daughter. The male denied the allegation and started walking away. The female retrieved a two-by-four, with nails driven through it, and followed male. The female struck male several times across the front of his body. There was no evidence the male was hit with the nails. The male said he pulled out a black replica hand gun to defend himself. The female was arrested for Assault with a Deadly Weapon and transported to Hercules Police Department. During the booking process, the female complained said she thought she was having a miscarriage. The female was transported, by ambulance, to County Hospital. She was released pending further investigation. The male was found to have a misdemeanor warrant. He was cited out for Brandishing an Altered BB Gun and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility for the warrant.

**Warrant Arrest** On October 20<sup>th</sup> 2016 at approximately 10:30PM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop, on a green 1994 Toyota Tarcel, in the 1500

block of Sycamore Ave. 21 year old Jessica Lea Flathers, of Napa, had a no bail warrant out of Sonoma County She was placed under arrest and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Mental Health Evaluation** On October 21<sup>st</sup> 2016 at approximately 12:35AM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 1900 block of Lupine Rd for a female who said she wanted to kill herself. Officers located a 20 year old female, who was visibly distraught, and crying. She told the officers she wanted to kill herself tonight. She was determined to meet the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. She was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

**Identity Theft:** On October 21, 2016 at 3:27pm an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Dogwood Ct for a report of identity theft. The reporting party said her bank informed her of suspicious activity on one of her accounts. An unknown person tried to cash a fraudulent check created from one of victim's credit cards accounts.

**Suspicious Circumstance** On October 22<sup>nd</sup> 2016 at approximately 4:00AM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Regatta for an adult male who was running away from a silver vehicle with the alarm going off. Officers were not able to locate the subject. The vehicle was a silver Nissan Murano registered in the 1100 block of Regatta. The driver's door was open but no theft was confirmed. Officers were not able to contact the registered owner, and a notification card was left to contact HPD.

**Domestic Violence/Criminal Threats/Brandishing a weapon not a firearm** On October 22<sup>nd</sup> 2016 at approximately 4:53AM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise Dr for a physical altercation between a husband and wife. The investigation indicated the 24 year old wife slapped/punched her adult husband in the face. The victim sustained cuts to his face and lips but declined medical attention. The female brandished a knife at the victim and stated she would kill him, and herself, prior to leaving the residence with a knife. The female returned to the residence and was placed under arrest. She was transported to HPD. During the interview it was determined the female met the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. She was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

**Warrant Arrest:** On October 22, 2016 at 8:00am an officer responded to the Napa County Detention Facility to take custody of 23 year old Brenda Rodriguez on our warrant. Rodriguez was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Identity Theft (BobCop):** On October 22, 2106 at 5:00pm, a supervisor handled an online police report regarding an identity theft. The reporting party said someone fraudulently opened an EBMUD account in his name.

**Identity Theft (BobCop):** On October 22, 2106 at 5:02pm, a supervisor handled an online police report regarding an identity theft. The reporting party was contacted, after applying for food stamps, through a State of California program. He was told someone is using his SSN and working in San Diego, CA.

**Driving under the influence of alcohol:** On October 23, 2016 at 2:12 an officer stopped 44 year old Nelson Alvarez, for DUI indicators, on Hercules Ave at Titan. The Standard Field Sobriety Test was administered; and the Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated Alvarez was above the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. He was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility

**Use, Discharge or Carrying of Weapons Prohibited/Towed Vehicle – False Tab:** On October 23, 2016 at 9:04 a.m. an officer checked an unoccupied Black '96 Honda Accord parked in lot of Chase Bank, 3600 San Pablo Ave. The officer was contacted by the Accord's owner. The owner was advised the Accord's registration expired as of September 2014, but had a 2017 year tab affixed to the rear license plate. The owner admitted he placed the 2017 year tab on his Accord. The owner was told the Accord was being towed and he told Officers he had a BB gun underneath the driver's seat. The officer located a Beretta 92/96 style Air Pistol, loaded with .177 BB pellets, underneath the driver's seat. 27 year old Immanuel Hayes cited/released, and the Air Pistol was taken for evidence.

**Auto Burglary:** On October 23, 2016 at 8:23 PM an officer was dispatched to an auto burglary in the 1200 block of Willow Ave. The Antioch resident stated she parked and locked her 2007 Kia Sorrento at 7:30 AM and returned at 10:51 PM. She found the right rear passenger window shattered. The glove box and center console open but nothing was missing.

**Stolen Vehicle VC 10851:** On October 24, 2016 at 5:31 AM an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Glenwood for a stolen vehicle. The reporting party stated she last saw her 1997 Red Acura at 7:00 pm. She did not hear or see anything during the night.
