Registration Requirements

Children must be the required age by September 1 of the school year in which they are registering. Children must be fully potty trained (no pull-ups please). Priority registration for current Tiny Tots Families will be from 2/27/17-3/17/17. Public registration will start on 3/22/17 at the Community Center and is first come, first serve. Full registration packet must be completed at the time of registration. Registration packets will be available online on Monday, March 20th.



Payment options for 2017-2018 Tiny Tots program

Option 1: No registration fee. Pay in full by August 20, 2017. 50% due at time of registration and 50% due by 1st day of the program.

Option 2: \$50.00 registration fee. 4 equal payments paid in full by April 20, 2018. Payments due: August 20th/October 20th/January 20th/April 20th. A payment book will be emailed to the provided email address. You will not receive an email reminder, if payment is not received by the 20th of the month, you will receive a \$35.00 late fee on the 21st of the month.

Option 3: \$100.00 due at time of registration. 9 equal payments (August 20, 2017-April 20, 2018) paid in full. A payment book will be emailed to the provided email address. You will not receive an email reminder, if payment is not received by the 20th of the month, you will receive a \$35.00 late fee on the 21st of the month. After the third late payment, participant will be dropped from the program.

Payment options for 2017-2018 Dynamite After School Program
Option 1: No registration fee. Pay in full by August 20, 2017. 50% at time of registration and 50% by 1st day of the program. Rate is \$5.50 per hour.
Option 2: \$50.00 registration fee. 4 equal payments paid in full by April 20, 2018. Payments due: August 20th/October 20th/January 20th/April 20th. A payment book will be emailed to the provided email address. You will not receive an email reminder, if payment is not received by the 20th of the month, you will receive a \$35.00 late fee on the 21st. Rate is \$5.75 per hour.
Option 3: \$100.00 due at time of registration. 9 equal payments (August 20, 2017-April 20, 2018) paid in full. A payment book will be emailed to the provided email address. You will not receive an email reminder, if payment is not received by the 20th of the month, you will receive a \$35.00 late fee on the 21st. After the third late payment, participant will be dropped from the program. Rate is \$6.00 per hour.

Registration information for the 2017-2018 School Year
Current families can get priority registration for the 2017-2018 school year from February 27, 2017 to March 17, 2017.
Public registration starts on March 22, 2017 at the Community Center. Registration is accepted on a first come, first serve basis. At the time of registration, the full packet must be completed and the pay option must be chosen. We cannot accept a registration packet that's not completed.
There is a \$75.00 program withdrawal fee that is due at the time of registration. This fee will be credited onto your household account at the end of the school year if you do not withdrawal from the program. If you withdrawal from the program early, the \$75.00 fee will be forfeited. You must complete a program change form and give a minimum of two week notice in order to withdrawal from the program.
